Linked Single Crochet (Lsc) Set-up st: Ch 1, sc in first ch or st.





Insert hook in bottom vertical bars of previous st, yo, draw up a lp (2 lps on hook).





Yo, insert hook in between bottom vertical bars of previous st, yo, draw up a lp (*3 lps on hook*).





Yo, sk next ch or st, insert hook in next ch or st, yo, draw up a lp to height of previous st, [yo, insert hook in same ch or st, yo, draw up a lp to same height as st] 3 times (11 lps on hook).





Yo, draw through all 11 lps on hook.



Ch 1 to lock.









Notes: Ch-1 to lock Lpuff st does not count as a st and is always skipped.

Foundation ch needs to be worked loosely or else finished piece will curve. Top swatch below is chaining normally, and bottom is when chained loosely.

If working Lpuff sts on top of Lpuff sts, do not skip any sts.



Rnd 4: Set-up Ldc in same st as joining, Ldc in same st, Ldc in each of next 2 sts, [2 Ldc in next st, Ldc in each of next 2 sts] around, join in first Ldc, change color to Detroit blue. (*48 Ldc*)

Rnd 5: Set-up Ldc in same st as joining, Ldc in same st, Ldc in each of next 3 sts, [2 Ldc in next st, Ldc in each of next 3 sts] around, join in first Ldc. *(60 Ldc)*





Note: Place a stitch marker in first, 3rd, 5th, 7th, 9th, 11th, 13th and 15th Lpuff sts. Move stitch markers up each rnd as work progresses.

Rnd 3: Join papaya in joining, set-up Lpuff st in first st, Lpuff st in same st, moving stitch markers as work progresses, [Lpuff st in each unmarked st, 2 Lpuff sts in each marked st] around, join in first Lpuff st, fasten off, do not turn. (24 Lpuff sts)

Rnd 4: Rep rnd 3 with lime. (32 Lpuff sts)

Rnd 5: Rep rnd 3 with turquoise. (40 Lpuff sts)

Row 2: Set-up Ltr, Ltr in each Ltr across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 3: Join (see Pattern Notes) teal, **set-up Lhdc** (see Special Stitches on page 2), **Lhdc** (see Special Stitches on page 2) in each st across, turn.

Row 4: Set-up Lhdc, Lhdc in each rem st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 5: Join grey, **set-up Ldc** (see Special Stitches on page 3), **Ldc** (see Special Stitches on page 3) in each rem st across, turn.

Rows 6 & 7: Set-up Ldc, Ldc in each st across, turn. At the end of row 7, fasten off.

Row 8: Join sunflower, set-up Ltr, Ltr in each rem st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 9: Join white, **set-up Ldtr** (see Special Stitches on page 5), **Ldtr** (see Special Stitches on page 5) in each rem st across, turn. Fasten off.

Rows 10 & 11: Join teal, rep row 5. At the end of row 11, fasten off.

Row 12: Join grey, set-up Lhdc, Lhdc in each rem st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 13: Join sunflower, set-up Ldtr, Ldtr in each rem st across, turn.

Row 14: Set-up Ldtr, Ldtr in each rem st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 15: With grey, set-up Ldc, [**Lsc** (*see Special Stitches on page 2*) in next st, Ldc in next st] across, turn. (63 Lsc, 64 Ldc)

Row 16: Set-up Lsc (see Special Stitches on page 2) in first Ldc, [Ldc in next Lsc, Lsc in next Ldc] across, turn.

Row 17: Set-up Ldc in Lsc, [Lsc in next Ldc, Ldc in next Lsc] across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 18: Join white, **set-up Lpuff st** (see Special Stitches on page 6), [sk next st, **Lpuff st** (see Special Stitches on page 6) in next st] across turn. (64 Lpuff sts)

Row 19: Set-up Lpuff st, Lpuff st in each Lpuff st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 20: Join teal, set-up Ldc in first Lpuff st, Lhdc in same st, [Ldc, Lhdc] in each Lpuff st across, ending with 1 Ldc in last Lpuff st, turn. *(127 sts)*

Rows 21–23: Set-up Ldc and Lhdc in first Lhdc, [sk next st, Ldc, Lhdc] in next Lhdc] across, ending with Ldc in last Ldc, turn. At the end of row 23, fasten off.

Row 24: Join sunflower, set-up Lpuff st in first Ldc, [sk next Lhdc, Lpuff st in next Ldc] across, turn. Fasten off. (64 Lpuff sts)

Row 25: Join white, set-up Ldc in first Lpuff st, Ldc in same st, [2 Lsc in next Lpuff st, 2 Ldc in next Lpuff st] across, ending with Lsc in last Lpuff st, turn. (127 sts)

Row 26: Set-up Ldc in first Lsc, Lsc in each of next 2 Ldc, [Ldc in each of next 2 Lsc, Lsc in each of next 2 Ldc] across, turn.

Row 27: Set-up Ldc in first Lsc, Ldc in next Lsc, [Lsc in each of next 2 Ldc, Lsc in each of next 2 Lsc] across, ending with Lsc in last Ldc, turn. Fasten off.

Row 28: Rep row 15. Fasten off.

Row 29: Join teal, rep row 16.

Row 30: Rep row 17.

Row 31: Join sunflower, set-up Ltr, Ltr in each st across, turn.

Row 32: Set-up Ltr, Ltr in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 33: Join teal, set-up Lhdc, Lhdc in each st across, turn. Fasten off. (*127 Lhdc*)

Row 34: Join grey, set-up Lpuff st in first st, sk next st, 2 Ldc in next st, [sk next st, Lpuff st in next st, sk next st, 2 Ldc in next st] across, turn. (*32 Lpuff sts, 64 dc*)

Rows 35 & 36: Ldc in each Ldc, Lpuff st in each Lpuff st across, turn. At the end of row 36, fasten off.

Row 37: Join white, [Lhdc in each Ldc, 2 Lhdc in each puff st] across to last puff st, ending with 1 Lhdc in last puff st, turn. *(127 sts)*

Row 38: Set-up Lhdc, Lhdc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 39: Join sunflower, set-up Ldc in first Lhdc, [Lsc in next Lhdc, Ldc in next Lhdc] across, turn.

Row 40: Set-up Lsc in Ldc, [Ldc in each Lsc, Lsc in each Ldc] across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 41: Rep row 33. Fasten off.

Row 42: Join grey, rep row 18.

Rows 43 & 44: Rep row 19. At the end of row 44, fasten off.

Row 45: Join white, set-up Ldc in first Lpuff st, 2 Ldc in each Lpuff st across, turn. Fasten off. (*127 Ldc*)

Row 46: Join sunflower, set-up Ldc in first Ldc, [Lhdc in each Ldc, Ldc in next Ldc] across, turn.

Row 47: Set-up Lhdc in first Ldc, [Ldc in next Lhdc, Lhdc in next Ldc] across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 48: Join white, set-up Ldc in first st, Ldc in each st across, turn.

Rows 49-51: Rep rows 42-44.

Row 52: Join teal, rep row 45.

Row 53: Join sunflower, set-up Ldc in first Ldc, [Lsc in next Ldc, Ldc in next Ldc] across, turn.

Row 54: Rep row 40.

Rows 55 & 56: Join white, set-up Lhdc, Lhdc in each st across, turn.

Rows 57-59: Rep rows 34-36.

Row 60: Join teal, set-up Lhdc, [2 Lhdc in Lpuff st, Lhdc in each of next 2 Ldc] across, turn.

Rows 61 & 62: Rep rows 31 and 32.

Row 63: Join teal, ch 1, sc in first Ltr, [Ldc in next Ltr, Lsc in next Ltr] across, turn.

Row 64: Rep row 17.

Row 65: Join grey, set-up Ldc, Ldc in each st across, turn. (*127 Ldc*)

Row 66: Join white, set-up Ldc, [Lsc in each of next 2 sts, Ldc in each of next 2 sts] across, turn.

Rows 67 & 68: [Ldc in each Lsc, Lsc in each Ldc] across, turn. At the end of row 68, fasten off.

Row 69: Join sunflower, set-up Lpuff st, [sk next st, Lpuff st in next st] across, turn. (*64 Lpuff sts*)

Row 70: Join teal, set-up Ldc in first st, Lhdc in same st, [Ldc and Lhdc] in each Lpuff st across to last st, Ldc in last Lpuff st, turn.

Row 71: Set-up Lhdc, [Ldc in Lhdc, Lhdc in next Ldc] across, turn.

Rows 72 & 73: [Ldc in each Lhdc, Lhdc in each Ldc] across, turn. At the end of row 73, fasten off.

Row 74: Join white, set-up Lpuff st, [sk next st, Lpuff st in next st] across, turn. *(64 Lpuff sts)*

Row 75: Lpuff st in each Lpuff st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 76: Join grey, [set-up Ldc, Lsc in same st, [Ldc, Lsc] in each Lpuff st across, ending with Ldc in last Lpuff st, turn. (*127 sts*)

Row 77: Ch 1, sc in first st, [Ldc in each Lsc, Lsc in each Ldc] across, turn.

Row 78: Set-up Ldc, [Lsc in each Ldc, Ldc in each Lsc] across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 79: Join sunflower, set-up Ldtr, Ldtr in each st across, turn.

Row 80: Set-up Ldtr, Ldtr in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 81: Join grey, set-up Lhdc, Lhdc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 82: Join teal, set-up Ldc, Ldc in each st across, turn.

Row 83: Set-up Ldc, Ldc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 84: Join white, set-up Ldtr, Ldtr in each st across, turn.

Row 85: Join sunflower, set-up Ltr, Ltr in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 86: Join grey, set-up Ldc, Ldc in each st across, turn.

Rows 87 & 88: Set-up Ldc, Ldc in each st across, turn. At the end of row 88, fasten off.

Row 89: Join teal, set-up Lhdc, Lhdc in each st across, turn.


Row 90: Set-up Lhdc, Lhdc in each st across, turn Fasten off.

Row 91: Join white, set-up Ltr, Ltr in each st across, turn.

Row 92: Set-up Ltr, Ltr in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

Border

Rnd 1 (RS): Join white in top right corner st, ch 1, 3 sc in corner st, sc in each st across row 92, 3 sc in last st for corner, *working down side edge of rows, work 2 sc in each Lhdc row, 2 sc in each Ldc row, 3 sc in each Lpuff st row and Ltr rows, 4 sc in each Ldtr row*, 3 sc in next corner st, sc in each st across opposite side of foundation ch, 3 sc in corner st, rep from * to * on opposite long edge of Afghan, join in beg sc. Fasten off. ●
