## TANK LID COVER <br> SKILL LEVEL

## $\square \square \square \square$ <br> INTERMEDIATE

## FINISHED SIZE

Fits standard-size commode tank lid

## MATERIALS

- Medium (worsted) weight yarn: $5 \mathrm{oz} / 250 \mathrm{yds} / 142 \mathrm{~g}$ variegated blue $2 \mathrm{oz} / 100 \mathrm{yds} / 57 \mathrm{~g}$ light periwinkle
- Size G/6/4mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Sewing needle
- Sewing thread
- Narrow elastic: 1 yd


## GAUGE

$4 \mathrm{dc}=1$ inch; 2 dc rows $=1$ inch

## PATTERN NOTES

Chain-3 at beginning of row or round counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

MEDIUM
Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCH

Knot stitch (knot st): Tr in next st, sc in next st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## COVER

Row 1: With variegated blue, ch 95, dc in 4th ch from hook (first 3 chs count as first dc), dc in each rem ch across, turn. ( 93 dc )

Rows 2-9: Ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), dc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.

Row 10 (WS): Join light periwinkle with sc in first st, knot st (see Special Stitch) across, do not turn. Fasten off.

Tr should bend toward the RS of the work.
Row 11: Join light periwinkle with sc in first st at beg of last row, knot st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 12: With RS facing, join (see Pattern Notes) variegated blue in first st, ch 3, dc in each rem st across, turn.

Rows 13-20: Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, do not turn.

Rnd 21: Now working in rnds, ch 1 , evenly sp 36 sc across ends of rows, working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 , sc in each st across, evenly sp 36 sc across ends of rows, sc in each st across row 20 , join in beg sc.

Rnd 22: Ch 4, sk next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, sk next st] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-4. Fasten off.

FINISHING
Cut elastic to fit under rim of commode tank lid.
Weave elastic through sts on last rnd.
Sew or tie ends tog.


## TISSUE BOX COVER

SKILL LEVEL
intermediate
FINISHED SIZE
Fits $43 / 4 \times 91 / 2 \times 3$-inch box of tissues

## MATERIALS

- Medium (worsted) weight yarn: $4 \mathrm{oz} / 200 \mathrm{yds} / 113 \mathrm{~g}$ variegated blue $2 \mathrm{oz} / 100 \mathrm{yds} / 57 \mathrm{~g}$ light periwinkle
- Size G/6/4mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE
$4 \mathrm{sc}=1$ inch; 4 sc rows $=1$ inch

## PATTERN NOTE

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCH

Knot stitch (knot st): Tr in next st, sc in next st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## COVER

TOP
MAKE 2.
Row 1: With variegated blue, ch 40 , sc in 2 nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. Fasten off. (39 sc)

Row 2 (WS): Join light periwinkle with sc in first st, knot st (see Special Stitch) across, turn. Fasten off.

Tr should bend toward the RS of the work.
Row 3: Join variegated blue with sc in first st, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 4: Join light periwinkle with sc in first st, knot st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 5: Join variegated blue with sc in first st, sc in each st, across, turn.

Rows 6-10: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.


Match bottom of row 1 on each piece tog, sew 6 sts at each end of matched edges tog leaving middle sts unsewn for center opening.

## SIDES

Rnd 1: Now working in rnds around outer edge of assembled Cover Top, join variegated blue with sc in last st of row 10 at 1 corner st, sc in same st, working in ends of rows, evenly sp 21 sc in ends of rows across, 2 sc in next corner st, sc in each st across to next corner, 2 sc in next corner st, working in ends of rows, evenly sp 21 sc in ends of rows across, 2 sc in next corner st, sc in each st across to first corner, do not join. (124 sc)

Rnd 2: [Sc in each of next 11 sts , sc dec (see Stitch Guide) in next 2 sts] 9 times, sc in each of next 5 sts, sc dec in last 2 sts. ( 114 sc )

Rnds 3-11: Sc in each st around. At end of last rnd, join (see Pattern Note) in beg sc. Fasten off.

## SEAT LID COVER

SKILL LEVEL

## INTERMEDIATE

## FINISHED SIZE

Fits standard round toilet seat lid

## MATERIALS

- Medium (worsted) weight yarn: $5 \mathrm{oz} / 250 \mathrm{yds} / 142 \mathrm{~g}$ variegated blue $1 \mathrm{oz} / 50 \mathrm{yds} / 28 \mathrm{~g}$ light periwinkle


MEDIUM

- Size G/6/4mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Narrow white elastic: 1 yd


## GAUGE

$4 \mathrm{dc}=1$ inch; 2 dc rows $=1$ inch

## PATTERN NOTES

Chain-3 at beginning of row or round counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCH

Knot stitch (knot st): Tr in next st, sc in next st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

COVER
Rnd 1: With variegated blue, ch 4 , sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), 11 dc in ring, join 3rd ch of beg ch 3 . ( 12 dc )

Rnd 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in each st around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (24dc)

Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in next st, [2 dc in next st, dc in next st] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (36 dc)

Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in next 2 sts, [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 2 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. ( 48 dc )

Rnd 5: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 sts, [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 3 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. ( 60 dc )

Rnd 6: Ch 3, dc in each of next 4 sts, [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 4 sts ] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. ( $72 d c$ )

Rnd 7: Ch 3, dc in each of next 5 sts, [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 5 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (84 dc)

Rnd 8: Ch 3, dc in each of next 6 sts, [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 6 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (96 dc)

Rnd 9: Ch 3, dc in each of next 7 sts , [2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 7 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (108 dc)

Rnd 10: Working in back lps (see Stitch Guide), ch 3 , dc in each of next 5 sts , [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 5 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (126 dc)

Rnds 11 \& 12: Rep rnds 8 and 9. At end of last rnd, fasten off. (162 dc at end of last rnd)

Rnd 13: With WS facing, join light periwinkle with sc in first st of last rnd, knot st (see Special Stitch) around, tr in last st, join in beg sc.

Tr should bend toward the RS of the work.
Rnd 14: Ch 1 , sc in first st, knot st around, tr in last st, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

Turn back to RS of work.
Rnd 15: With RS facing, join variegated blue in first st of last rnd, ch 3, dc in each st around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 16: Ch 3, dc in each of next 8 sts, $[2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st, dc in each of next 8 sts ] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (180 dc)

Rnds 17 \& 18: Ch 3, dc in each st around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 19: Ch 4, sk next st, [dc in next st, ch 1 , sk next st] around, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-4. Fasten off.

## CENTER RIDGE

With outer edge of Cover pointing facing, working in rem lps of rnd 9 , join light periwinkle with sc in any st, knot st around, tr in last st, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave elastic through sts of rnd 19 ; sew or tie ends tog.

## RUG <br> SKILL LEVEL <br> INTERMEDIATE

## FINISHED SIZE

25 inches across

## MATERIALS

- Medium (worsted) weight yarn: $8 \mathrm{oz} / 400 \mathrm{yds} / 227 \mathrm{~g}$ variegated blue $4 \mathrm{oz} / 200 \mathrm{yds} / 113 \mathrm{~g}$ light periwinkle

- Size G/6/4mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge


## GAUGE

$4 \mathrm{dc}=1$ inch; 2 dc rows $=1$ inch

## PATTERN NOTES

Use rug backing on back of rugs that are placed on floors other than carpet.

Chain-3 at beginning of row or round counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCH

Knot stitch (knot st): Tr in next st, sc in next st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## RUG

Rnd 1: With variegated blue, ch 4, sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), 11 dc in ring, join (see Pattern Notes) in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (12dc)


Rnd 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in each st around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (24dc)

Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in next st, [ 2 dc in next st, dc in next st] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (36 dc)

Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in each of next 2 sts , [2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 2 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (48dc)

Rnd 5: Ch 3, dc in each of next 3 sts , [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 3 sts ] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. ( 60 dc )

Rnd 6: Ch 3, dc in each of next 4 sts , [2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 4 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (72dc)

Rnd 7: Ch 3, dc in each of next 5 sts, [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 5 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. ( $84 d c$ )

Rnd 8: Ch 3, dc in each of next 6 sts , [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 6 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (96 dc)

Rnd 9: Ch 3, dc in each of next 7 sts, [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 7 sts ] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (108 dc)

Rnd 10: Working in back lps (see Stitch Guide), ch 3 , dc in each of next 8 sts, [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 8 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. ( 120 dc )

Rnd 11: Ch 3, dc in each of next 9 sts , [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 9 sts ] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (132dc)

Rnd 12: Ch 3, dc in each of next 10 sts , [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 10 sts] around, dc in
same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off. (144 dc)

Rnd 13: With WS facing, join light periwinkle with sc in first st of last rnd, knot st (see Special Stitch) around, tr in last st, join in beg sc.

Tr should bend toward the RS of work.
Rnd 14: Ch 1 , sc in first st, knot st around, tr in last st, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

Turn back to RS of work.
Rnd 15: Join variegated blue in first st of last rnd, ch 3 , dc in each of next 11 sts, [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 11 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (156 dc)

Rnd 16: Ch 3, dc in each of next 12 sts , [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 12 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (168 dc)

Rnd 17: Ch 3, dc in each of next 13 sts , [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 13 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. ( 180 dc )

Rnd 18: Ch 3, dc in each of next 14 sts , [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 14 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off. (192 dc)

Rnds 19 \& 20: Rep rnds 13 and 14.
Rnd 21: Join variegated blue in first st of last rnd, ch 3 , dc in each of next 15 sts , 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 15 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (204 dc)

Rnd 22: Ch 3, dc in each of next 16 sts , [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 16 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (216dc)

Rnd 23: Ch 3, dc in each of next 17 sts , [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 17 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (228dc)

Rnd 24: Ch 3, dc in each of next 18 sts , [2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 18 sts] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (240 dc)

Rnd 25: Ch 3, dc in each of next 19 sts , [ 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 19 sts ] around, dc in same st as joining sl st of last rnd, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. Fasten off. ( 252 dc )

Rnds 26 \& 27: Rep rnds 13 and 14.

## CENTER RIDGE

With outer edge of Rug pointing toward you, working in rem lps of rnd 9, join light periwinkle with sc in any st, $t r$ in next st, knot st around, tr in last st, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

## TISSUE ROLL COVER <br> SKILL LEVEL <br> 

## FINISHED SIZE

Fits standard-size roll of bath tissue

## MATERIALS

- Medium (worsted) weight yarn: $2 \mathrm{oz} / 100 \mathrm{yds} / 57 \mathrm{~g}$ variegated blue $1 / 2 \mathrm{oz} / 25 \mathrm{yds} / 14 \mathrm{~g}$ light periwinkle

- Size G/6/4mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge


## GAUGE

$4 \mathrm{sc}=1$ inch; 4 sc rows $=1$ inch

## PATTERN NOTE

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless
otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCH

Knot stitch (knot st): Tr in next st, sc in next st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## COVER

Rnd 1: With variegated blue, ch 4 , sl st in first ch to form ring, ch $1,10 \mathrm{sc}$ in ring, join (see Pattern Note in beg sc. (10 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around, join in beg sc. (20 sc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1 , sc in first st, 2 sc in next st, [sc in next st, 2 sc in next st] around, join in beg sc. (30 sc)

Rnd 4: Ch 1 , sc in each st around, join in beg sc.
Rnd 5: Ch 1 , sc in each of first 2 sts, 2 sc in next st, [sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st] around, join in beg sc. (40 sc)

Rnds 6 \& 7: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join in beg sc.

Rnd 8: Ch 1 , sc in each of first 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, [sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) around, join in beg sc. ( 50 sc )

Rnd 9: Ch 1 , sc in each st around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

Rnd 10: With WS facing, join light periwinkle with sc in first st of last rnd, knot st (see Special Stitch) around, tr in last st, join with sl st in beg sc.

Tr should bend toward the RS of work.
Rnd 11: Ch 1, sc in first st, knot st around, tr in last st, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

Turn to RS of work.
Rnd 12: Join variegated blue in first st of last rnd, ch 1 , sc in each st around, join in beg sc.

Rnds 13-29: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join. At end of last rnd, fasten off.

Rnds 30 \& 31: Rep rnds 10 and 11 .

## FINISHED SIZE

271/2 x 43 inches

## MATERIALS

- Light (sport) weight yarn:
$4 \mathrm{oz} / 360 \mathrm{yds} / 113 \mathrm{~g}$ off-white
- Medium (worsted) weight yarn: $30 \mathrm{oz} / 1,500 \mathrm{yds} / 851 \mathrm{~g}$ green
- Sizes G/6/4mm and H/8/5mm crochet hooks or sizes needed to obtain gauge
■ Tapestry needle


## GAUGE

Size G hook: 4 hdc = 1 inch

Size H hook: $7 \mathrm{hdc}=2$ inches; 5 hdc rows $=$ 2 inches

## PATTERN NOTES

Use size H hook unless otherwise stated.

Chain-2 at beginning of row or round counts as first half double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

Chain-3 at beginning of row or round counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## RUG

Rnd 1: With size H hook (see Pattern Notes) and green, ch 46, working in back bar of ch (see Fig. 1), 4 hdc in 3 rd ch from hook (first 2 chs count
as first hdc), hdc in each ch across to last ch, 5 hdc in last ch, working on opposite side of ch in back lps (see Stitch Guide), hdc in each ch across, join (see Pattern Notes) in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. (94 hdc)

Back Bar of Chain
Rnd 2: Working this rnd and rem rnds in back lps, ch 2 (see Pattern Notes), hdc in same st, 2 hdc in each of next 4 sts, hdc in each of next 42 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 5 sts, hdc in each of last 42 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. (104 hdc)

Rnd 3: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in next st, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next st] 4 times, hdc in each of next 42 sts, [ hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st] 5 times, hdc in each of last 42 sts, join in 2 nd ch of beg ch-2. (114 hdc)

Rnd 4: Ch 2, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, [hdc in each of next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 4 times, hdc in each of next 42 sts , [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 2 sts] 5 times, hdc in each of last 42 sts, join in 2 nd ch of beg ch-2. ( 124 hdc )

Rnd 5: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in each of next 3 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 3 sts] 4 times, hdc in each of next 42 sts, [hdc in each of next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 5 times, hdc in each of last 42 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. (134 hdc)

Rnd 6: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st, [hdc in each of next 4 sts , 2 hdc in next st] 4 times, hdc in each of next 42 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 4 sts] 5 times, hdc in each of last 42 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. (144 hdc)

Rnd 7: Ch 2, hdc in same st, hdc in each of next 5 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 5 sts] 4 times, hdc in each of next 42 sts, [hdc in each of next $5 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in next st] 5 times, hdc in each of last 42 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. (154 hdc)

Rnd 8: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 5 sts, 2 hdc in next st, [hdc in each of next 6 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 4 times, hdc in each of next 42 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 6 sts] 5 times, hdc in each of last 42 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. ( 164 hdc )

Rnd 9: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 3 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 7 sts] 5 times, hdc in each of next 42 sts, [hdc in each of next 7 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 5 times, hdc in each of last 38 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. ( 174 hdc )

Rnd 10: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 3 sts, [hdc in each of next 8 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 5 times, hdc in each of next 42 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 8 sts] 5 times, hdc in each of last 38 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. ( 184 hdc )

Rnd 11: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 3 sts , 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 9 sts] 5 times, hdc in each of next 42 sts, [hdc in each of next 9 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 5 times, hdc in each of last 38 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. (194 hdc)

Rnd 12: Ch 2 , hdc in each of next 3 sts, [hdc in each of next 10 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 5 times, hdc in each of next 42 sts , 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 10 sts$] 5$ times, hdc in each of last 38 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. (204 hdc)

Rnd 13: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 3 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 11 sts$] 5$ times, hdc in each of next 42 sts, [hdc in each of next 11 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 5 times, hdc in each of last 38 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. (214 hdc)

Rnd 14: Ch 2 , hdc in each of next 3 sts, [hdc in each of next $12 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in next st] 5 times, hdc in each of next 42 sts , [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 12 sts ] 5 times, hdc in each of last 38 sts, join in 2 nd ch of beg ch-2. (224hdc)

Rnd 15: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 7 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 13 sts] 5 times, hdc in each of next 42 sts, [hdc in each of next 13 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 5 times, hdc in each of last 34 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. ( 234 hdc )

Rnd 16: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 7 sts, [hdc in each of next $14 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in next st] 5 times, hdc in each of next 42 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 14 sts$] 5$ times, hdc in each of last 34 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. (244 hdc)

Rnd 17: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 7 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 15 sts$] 5$ times, hdc in each of next 42 sts, [hdc in each of next 15 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 5 times, hdc in each of last 34 sts join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. (254 hdc)

Rnd 18: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 7 sts, [hdc in each of next 16 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 5 times, hdc in each of next 42 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 16 sts] 5 times, hdc in each of last 34 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. (264 hdc)

Rnd 19: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 9 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 20 sts] 4 times, hdc in each of next 48 sts, [hdc in each of next 20 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 4 times, hdc in each of last 38 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. (272 hdc)

Rnd 20: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 9 sts, [hdc in each of next $21 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in next st] 4 times, hdc in each of next 48 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 21 sts$] 4$ times, hdc in each of last 38 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. (280 hdc)

Rnd 21: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 9 sts, [2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 22 sts] 4 times, hdc in each of next 48 sts, [hdc in each of next 22 sts, 2 hdc in next st] 4 times, hdc in each of last 38 sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. Fasten off. (288 hdc)

## CHAIN LOOPS

Starting at center of rnd 1 and working in rem lps, join green with sc in lp at end of rnd 1 opposite of joining sl st, [ch 7, sc in next lp] across, ${ }^{*}$ ch 1 , sc in first lp of next rnd, [ch 7, sc in next lp] around, rep from * to last rnd, join in beg sc on last rnd of Chain Loops. Leaving both lps of last rnd unworked, fasten off.

## LACE

Rnd 1: With RS of Rug facing, working in both lps of last rnd on Rug, join off-white in 13th st from joining at end of rnd, ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), dc in each of next 46 sts , 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 20 sts$] 3$ times, 2 dc in next st, dc in each of next 82 sts , 22 dc in next st , dc in each of next 20 sts$] 3$ times, 2 dc in next st, dc in each of last 31 sts, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (296 dc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1 , sc in each of first 2 sts, ch 3 , sk next 2 sts, [sc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3 , sk next 2 sts] around, join in beg sc. ( $148 \mathrm{sc}, 74 \mathrm{ch} s p s$ )

Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in next st, ch 3, sk next ch sp, [dc in each of next 2 sts, ch 3 , sk next ch sp] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 4: Ch 1 , sc in sp between ch 3 and next dc, ch 4 , sk next ch sp, [sc in sp between next 2 dc , ch 4 , sk next ch sp] around, join in beg sc. ( $74 \mathrm{sc}, 74 \mathrm{ch} s p s$ )

Rnd 5: Ch 1 , sc in first st, 5 sc in next ch sp,
[sc in next st, 5 sc in next ch sp] around, join in beg sc. (444 sc)

Rnd 6: Ch 1 , sc in first st, ch 1 , sk next 2 sts, (dc, ch $2, \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next st, ch 1 , sk next 2 sts, ${ }^{*}$ sc in next st, ch 1 , sk next 2 sts, (dc, ch $2, \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next st, ch 1 , sk next 2 sts, rep from * around, join in beg sc. ( $74 \mathrm{sc}, 74 \mathrm{ch}$ sps)

Rnd 7: Ch 1 , sc in first sc, 6 dc in next ch- 2 sp , [sc in next st, 6 sc in next ch-2 sp] around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

## RIBBON

With size G hook and green, ch 396, working in back bar of ch, hdc in 3rd ch from hook, hdc in each ch across. Fasten off.

Weave under and over 2 dc at a time through sps of rnd 3 on Lace.

Sew ends tog. Hide seam on WS of Lace.

## BOW

MAKE 2.
With size G hook and green, ch 53, working in back bar of ch, hdc in 3rd ch from hook, hdc in each ch across. Fasten off.

Fold according to diagram (see Fig. 2).

$7 \mathrm{hdc}=2$ inches; 5 hdc rows $=2$ inches

## PATTERN NOTES

Chain-2 at beginning of row or round counts as first half double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Work all rows beginning with row 2 alternating front and back loops. All unworked loops should be on same side of piece.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

## INSTRUCTIONS

## COVER

Row 1: Ch 28, working in back bar of ch (see Fig. 1), hdc in 3rd ch from hook (first 2 chs count as first hdc), hdc in each ch across to last ch, 5 hdc in last ch, working on opposite side of ch in back lps (see Stitch Guide), hdc in each ch across with last st in bottom of ch 2, turn. ( 57 hdc )

Row 4: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 25 sts, [2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of each of next 2 sts] 5 times, hdc in each of last 26 sts, turn. ( 72 hdc )

Row 5: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 25 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 3 sts] 5 times, hdc in each of last 26 sts, turn. ( 77 hdc )

Row 6: Ch 2 , hdc in each of next 25 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 4 sts 5 times, hdc in each of next 26 sts, turn. ( 82 hdc )

Row 7: Ch 2, hdc in each of next 25 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 5 sts] 5 times, hdc in each of last 26 sts, turn. ( 87 hdc )

Row 8: Ch 2 , hdc in each of next 25 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 6 sts $] 5$ times, hdc in each of last 26 sts, turn. ( 92 hdc )

Row 9: Ch 1 , sc in first st, hdc in each of next 25 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 7 sts ] 5 times, hdc in each of next 25 sts , sc in last st, turn. ( $95 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ )

Row 10: Sl st in each of first 2 sts, sc in next st, hdc in each of next 23 sts, [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 8 sts] 5 times, hdc in each of next 23 sts, sc in next st, sl st in next st leaving last st unworked, turn. ( $96 h d c, 2 s c, 3 s l s t s)$

Row 11: Sk first sl st, sl st in each of next 2 sts, sc in next st , hdc in each of next 21 sts , [2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 9 sts$] 5$ times, hdc in each of next 21 sts, sc in next st, sl st in next st leaving last 3 sts unworked, turn. ( $97 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$, $3 \mathrm{sl} s t s)$

Row 12: Sk first sl st, sl st in each of next 3 sts, sc in next st, hdc in each of next 18 st , [ 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each of next 10 sts] 5 times, hdc in each of next 18 sts, sc in next st, sl st in next st leaving last 4 sts unworked, turn. ( $96 \mathrm{hdc}, 2$ $s c, 4 s l s t s)$

Row 13: Sk first sl st, sl st in each of next 3 sts, sc in next st, hdc in each of next $32 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in next st, [hdc in each of next $12 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in next st] twice, hdc in each of next 31 sts , sc in next st, sl st in next st leaving last 5 sts unworked, turn. (93 hdc, 2 sc, 4 sl sts)

Row 14: Sk first sl st, sl st in each of next 3 sts, sc in next st, hdc in each of next 32 sts, 2 hdc in next st, [hdc in each of next 10 sts, 2 hdc in next st] twice, hdc in each of next 32 sts , sc in next st , sl st in next st leaving last 5 sts unworked, turn. (90 hdc, 2 sc, 4 sl sts)

Row 15: Sk first sl st, sl st in each of next 3 sts, sc in next st, hdc in each of next $31 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in next st, [hdc in each of next 9 sts, 2 hdc in next st] twice, hdc in each of next 32 sts , sc in next st, sl st in next st leaving last 5 sts unworked, turn. Fasten off. ( $87 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sl} s t \mathrm{~s}$ )

Rnd 16: Now working in rnds, around outer edge, join with sc in end of row 9 at right back corner, sc in end of each row and in each st around, join (see Pattern Notes) in beg sc. (139 sc)

Rnd 17: Ch 1 , sc in each st around, join in beg sc, turn.

Row 18: Working in rows through both lps of sts, ch 1 , sc in each of first 121 sts leaving last 18 sts unworked, turn. (121 sc)

Row 19: Ch 1 , sc in each of first 23 sts, sc dec (see Stitch Guide) in next 2 sts, [sc in each of next 16 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts ] 4 times, sc in each of last 24 sts, turn. (116sc)

Row 20: Leaving excess extended at each end, hold elastic over sts of last row, working over elastic (see Fig. 2), ch 1, sc in each st across. Fasten off.

Starting at center of row 1 and working in rem lps, join green with sc in lp at rounded end, [ch 7 , sc in next lp] across, ${ }^{*}$ ch 1 , sc in first lp of next rnd, [ch 7, sc in next lp] across, rep from * to last row. Leaving both lps of last rnd unworked, fasten off.

## FINISHING

Place Cover on lid of toilet, pull ends of elastic, gathering edge of cover to fit lid. Leaving $3 / 4$-inch end, cut off excess ends. Fold each end under, sew to back of last row on Cover to secure.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in sp between ch 3 and next dc, ch 3 , sk next ch sp, [sc in sp between next 2 dc , ch 3, sk next ch sp] around, join in beg sc. (55 sc, 55 ch $s p s$ )

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in first st, 2 sc in next ch sp, [sc in next st, 2 sc in next ch sp] around, join in beg sc. ( 165 sc)

Rnd 6: Ch 1 , sc in first st, ch 1 , sk next 2 sts, (dc, ch $2, \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next st, ${ }^{*} \mathrm{ch} 1$, sk next 2 sts, sc in next st, ch 1 , sk next 2 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next st, rep from * around to last 5 sts, ch 1 , sk next st, sc in next st, ch 1 , sk next st, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next st, ch 1 , sk last st, join in beg sc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in first sc, 6 dc in next ch- 2 sp , [sc in next st, 6 sc in next ch-2 sp] around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

## TRIM

With top of piece facing, working in front lps of rnd 1 on Lace, join off-white in any st, 3 sc in next st, [sl st in next st, 3 sc in next st] around, join beg sl st. Fasten off.

## RIBBON

With size G hook and green, ch 240, working in back bar of ch (see Fig. 1), hdc in 3rd ch from hook, hdc in each ch across. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: Sl st in first ch sp, ch 3, dc in same ch sp, ch 1 , sk next st, [ 2 dc in next ch sp, ch 1 , sk next st] around, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (24dc, 12 ch sps)

Rnd 5: Sl st in next st, ch 1, [sc in next ch, ch 3, sk next 2 sts] around, join in beg sc. ( 12 sc , 12 ch sps)

Rnd 6: Ch 1,3 sc in each ch sp around, join in beg sc. (36 sc)

Rnd 7: Ch 1 , sc in first st, ch 2 , sk next 2 sts, (dc, ch $2, \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next st, ch 2 , sk next 2 sts, *sc in next st, ch 2 , sk next 2 sts, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next st, ch 2 , sk next 2 sts, rep from * around, join in beg sc. ( $6 s c, 6 c h s p s$ )


Rnd 8: Ch 1 , sc in first sc, sk next ch-2 sp, 9 dc in next ch-2 sp, sk next ch-2 sp, [sc in next sc, sk next ch-2 sp, 9 dc in next ch-2 sp, sk next ch-2 sp] around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

## TRIM

With top of piece facing, working in front lps of rnd 1 on Lace, with size D hook and off-white, join in any st, 4 sc in next st, [sl st in next st, 4 sc in next st] around, join in beg sl st. Fasten off.

(116 sts)

Rnd 4: Ch 3, 3 dc in first st, dc in each of next 8 sts, 6 dc in next st, dc in each of next 48 sts, 6 dc in next st, dc in each of next 8 sts, 6 dc in next st, dc in each of next $48 \mathrm{sts}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in same st as beg 3 dc , sk ch-3 and join in top of beg dc. ( 136 dc )

Rnd 5: Ch 4 (does not count as first st), ( $\operatorname{tr}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same st, *dc in each of next 13 sts , ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{tr}$, 2 dc ) in next st, dc in each of next $53 \mathrm{sts}^{*}$, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next st, rep between * once, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{tr}$ ) in same st as beg tr , join in top of beg tr. (156 sts)

Rnd 6: Ch 3, 3 dc in first st, *dc in each of next 18 sts, 6 dc in next st, dc in each of next 58 sts*, 6 dc in next st, rep between * once, 3 dc in same st as beg 3 dc , join in top of beg dc. ( 176 dc )

Row 5: Join buff with sc in first st, ch 2, dc in each st across, do not turn. Fasten off.

## BACK SECTION

Row 6: Join light coral with fpsc (see Stitch Guide) around first dc on last row, ch 2, bpdc (see Stitch Guide) around each st across, do not turn. Fasten off.

Row 7: With dark blue, rep row 6.
Row 8: With country blue, rep row 6.
Row 9: With carrot, rep row 6.
Row 10: Join off-white with fpsc around first dc on last row, ch 2 , bpdc around each st across, turn. Do not fasten off.

## 18½-INCH SIZE ONLY

Rows [11 \& 12]: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 2, dc in each st across, turn.

## FOR BOTH SIZES

Row 11 [13]: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 2, [dc dec (see Stitch Guide) in next 2 sts] twice, dc in each st across to last 4 sts, [dc dec in next 2 sts] twice, turn. (44 dc)

Row 12 [14]: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 2, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in each st across to last 2 sts, dc dec in last 2 sts, turn. ( $42 d c$ )

Rows 13-18 [15-20]: *Rep rows 11 and 12 [13 and 14] alternately, rep from ${ }^{*} 1$ [2] times. At end of last row, fasten off. ( 24 sts at end of last row)


## FRONT SECTION

Row 19 [21]: Working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 , join light coral with fpsc around first dc, ch 2 , bpdc around each st across, do not turn. Fasten off.

Rows 20-23 [22-25]: Rep rows 7-10 of Back Section.

## 18½-INCH SIZE ONLY

Rows [26 \& 27]: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 2, dc in each st across, turn.

## FOR BOTH SIZES

Row 24 [28]: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 2, [dc dec in next 2 sts] twice, dc in each st across to last 4 sts, [dc dec in next 2 sts] twice, turn. (44 dc)

Row 25 [29]: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 2, dc dec in next 2 sts, dc in each st across to last 2 sts, dc dec in last 2 sts, turn. ( $42 d c$ )

Rows 26-32 [30-36]: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 2, [dc dec in next 2 sts] twice, dc in each st across to last 4 sts , [dc dec in next 2 sts ] twice, turn. At end of last row, fasten off. (14 sts at end of last row)

Rnd 33 [37]: Working in sts and in ends of rows around outer edge, join off-white with sc in row 18 at right back corner, sc in each st, sc in each sc row, 3 sc in each tr row and 2 sc in each dc row around, join (see Pattern Notes) in beg sc, turn. (164 [180] sc)

Row 34 [38]: Now working in rows, ch 1, sc in each of first 140 [156] sts, leave last 24 sts unworked, turn. (140 [156] sc)

Row 35 [39]: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.
Row 36 [40): Ch 1, sc in each of first 29 [33] sts, sc dec (see Stitch Guide) in next 2 sts, *sc in each of next 18 [20] sts, sc dec in next 2 sts, rep from * 3 times, sc in each of last 29 [33] sts, turn. (135 [151] sc)

Row 37 [41]: Hold elastic over sts of last row, leaving excess extended at each end; working over elastic (see Fig. 2), ch 1, sc in each st across. Fasten off.

## GAUGE

With 2 strands of yarn held tog: 5 sts $=2$ inches; 4 dc rows $=3$ inches

Use rug backing on back of rugs that are placed on floors other than carpet.

Hold 2 strands of yarn together unless otherwise stated.

For easier handling of yarn when changing colors, using 2 strands of yarn held together, wind 2 small balls each of carrot and light coral to be used for diamond.

When changing colors, always change in last stitch made.

Row 1 (RS): With 2 strands off-white held tog (see Pattern Notes), ch 56, sc in 2nd ch from hook, ch 1 (see Pattern Notes), hdc in each ch across, turn. (55 hdc)

Rows 2 \& 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 1, hdc in each of next 25 sts changing colors (see Stitch Guide and Pattern Notes) to 2 strands carrot in last st, drop last color to WS of work, pick up as needed; when changing colors, always drop yarn on same side of work; hdc in each of next 3 sts changing to 2 strands off-white in last st, hdc in each of rem last 26 sts, turn.

Rows 4 \& 5: Ch 1 , sc in first st, ch 1 , hdc in each of next 22 sts changing to carrot in last st, hdc in each of next 3 sts changing to light coral
in last st, hdc in each of next 3 sts changing to carrot in last st, hdc in each of next 3 sts changing to off-white in last st, hdc in each of rem last 23 sts, turn.

Rows 6 \& 7: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 1, hdc in each of next 19 sts changing to carrot in last st, hdc in each of next 3 sts changing to light coral in last st, hdc in each of next 9 sts changing to carrot in last st, hdc in each of next 3 sts changing to off-white in last st, hdc in rem last 20 sts, turn.

Rows 8 \& 9: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 1, hdc in each of next 16 sts changing to carrot in last st, hdc in each of next 3 sts changing to light coral in last st, hdc in each of next 6 sts changing to blue in last st, hdc in each of next 3 sts changing to light coral in last st, hdc in next 6 sts changing to carrot in last st, hdc in each of next 3 sts changing to off-white in last st, hdc in each of rem last 17 sts, turn.

Rows 10 \& 11: Rep rows 6 and 7.
Rows 12 \& 13: Rep rows 4 and 5.
Rows 14 \& 15: Rep rows 2 and 3.
Row 16: Ch 1 , $s c$ in first st, ch 1 , hdc in each of rem last sts across, turn.

Row 17: Ch 1 , sc in first st, ch 2, dc in each st across, do not turn. Fasten off.

## FIRST SIDE

Row 18: Join carrot with fpsc (see Stitch Guide) around first dc on last row, ch 2, bpdc (see Stitch Guide) around each of rem last sts across, do not turn. Fasten off.

Row 19: With country blue, rep row 18.
Row 20: With dark blue, rep row 18.
Row 21: With light coral, rep row 18.
Row 22: Join buff with fpsc around first dc on last row, ch 2 , bpdc around each of last rem sts of row, turn. Do not fasten off.

Row 23: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

Row 24: Sk first st, join carrot with sc in next st, ch 2 , tr in next st, [ch 1, sk next st, tr in each of next 2 sts] 17 times, sk last st, do not turn. Fasten off.

Row 25: Join buff with sc in first sk st on row before last, ch 3, [sc in each of next 2 sts, working in front of ch-1, tr in next sk st on row before last] 18 times, do not turn. Fasten off.

Row 26: Join buff with sc in first st, ch 2, dc in each of rem last sts across, do not turn. Fasten off.

Row 27: With light coral, rep row 18.
Row 28: With dark blue, rep row 18.
Row 29: With country blue, rep row 18.
Row 30: With carrot, rep row 18.
Row 31: Join off-white with fpsc around first dc on last row, ch 2, bpdc around each of rem last sts of row, turn. Do not fasten off.

Rows 32-37: Ch 1 , sc in first st, ch 2, dc in each of rem last sts across, turn. At end of last row, fasten off.


## 2ND SIDE

Row 38: Working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 , with RS facing, join off-white with $s c$ in first ch, ch $2, \mathrm{dc}$ in each of rem last chs across, do not turn. Fasten off.

Rows 39-58: Rep rows 18-37 of First Side.

## FINISHING

To block Rug, pin corners and sides of Rug on a padded surface, using yardstick as a guide for straightening edges.

Steam with iron or garment steamer, being careful iron does not touch yarn.

Allow to dry completely before removing pins.
To keep edges smooth and even, with tapestry needle and off-white, whipstitch across ends of post stitch rows on each side of Rug.

## FRINGE

Cut 6 strands off-white, each strand 11 inches long. With all 6 strands held tog, fold in half, insert hook in st, pull fold through st, pull ends through fold, tighten.

Attach Fringe in every other st across each end of Rug.

Rnd 10: Working in starting ch on opposite side of rnd 1 , join light coral with fpsc around first dc, ch 2, bpdc around each of rem last sts, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2.

Rnd 11: With dark blue, rep rnd 6.
Rnd 12: With country blue, rep rnd 6.
Rnd 13: With carrot, rep rnd 6.

## FINISHING

With Side piece facing, hold Side and Top WS tog, matching sts of rnd 2 on Top and rnd 9 on Side, working through both thicknesses, join carrot with sl st in any st, sl st in each st around, join in beg sl st. Fasten off.

 decrease (dc dec): (Yo, insert hook, yo, draw loop through, draw through 2 lps on hook) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.


Half double crochethdc: Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook.


Double crochet-dc: Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 $\mathrm{lps}]$ twice.


Change colors:
Drop first color; with 2nd color, pull through last 2 lps of st .


Treble crochet-tr: Yo twice, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 3 times.
