## FINISHED SIZE

One size fits most

## MATERIALS

- Deborah Norville Cuddle Fleece bulky (chunky) weight polyester yarn ( $31 / 2 \mathrm{oz} / 110 \mathrm{yds} / 100 \mathrm{~g}$ per skein):

1 skein \#2003 sassy

- Deborah Norville Serenity Chunky Heathers bulky (chunky) weight acrylic yarn ( $3 ½ \mathrm{oz} / 109 \mathrm{yds} / 100 \mathrm{~g}$ per skein): 1 skein \#0006 highland
- Sizes K/10½/6.5mm and M/13/9mm crochet hooks or sizes needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- 32mm \#372 pink buttons by Blumenthal Lansing: 2
- Stitch marker


## GAUGE

K hook: 7 sc = 3 inches; 6 sc rnds = 2 inches
M hook: 3 sc = 1 inch; 3 sc rnds = 1 inch

## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.
Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

Do not join rounds unless otherwise stated. Use stitch marker to mark rounds.

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These cozy mittens feature hand sections that are stitched in solid-color, chunky-weight yarn and accented with variegated fleece-yarn finger caps and cuffs.

## MITTENS

## RIGHT CUFF

Row 1: With size M hook and sassy, ch 7, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sl st in each rem ch, turn. (6 sl sts)
Row 2: Working in back lp (see Stitch Guide) of sts, sl st in each sl st across, turn.
Rows 3-30: Rep row 2.
Row 31: Holding opposite side of foundation ch of row 1 to top of row 30 , ch 1 , [working through both thicknesses in back lps, sl st in next sl st of row

30 and in next ch of opposite side of foundation ch of row 1] across to join ends of Cuff. (15 ribbing ridges)

## RIGHT MITTEN

Rnd 1: With size K hook, working in edge of Cuff rows, ch 1 , 2 sc in same sp as beg ch- 1, *[sk next ridge, sc in next sp between ridges] twice, sk next ridge, 2 sc in next sp between ridges, rep from * 4 times, join (see Pattern Notes) in first sc. Fasten off. (22 sc)

Rnd 2: Working in back lps, join highland in same st as joining of
rnd 1 , ch $1,2 \mathrm{sc}$ in first sc, sc in each sc around, join in first sc. (23 sc)
Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, do not join, place marker (see Pattern Notes). (23 sc)

Rnds 4-13: Sc in each sc around. At the end of rnd 13, turn Mitten to RS.
Rnd 14: Sc in each of next 17 sc , ch 3 , sk next 6 sc (Thumb opening). (17 sc)
Rnd 15: Sc in each of next 17 sc , sc in each of next 3 chs . ( 20 sc )
Rnd 16: Sc in each sc around.
Rnd 17: Sc in each of next 6 sc, working in back lp , sc in each of next 10 sc (top of hand where Mitten Top will be sewn), sc in both lps of rem 4 sc . $(20 \mathrm{sc}$ )
Rnds 18-21: Sc in each sc around. At the end of rnd 21, sl st in next sc, fasten off.

## RIGHT THUMB

Rnd 1 (RS): With size K hook, join highland to same sp as last sc of rnd 14 was worked, ch 1 , sc in same st as beg ch- 1 , sc in each of next 6 sc , sc in same sp as first sc of rnd 15 , sc in opposite side of each of next 3 chs. ( 11 sc )
Rnds 2-6: Sc in each sc around.
Rnds 7 \& 8: [Sc dec (see Stitch Guide) over next 2 sc$]$ around. At the end of rnd $8, \mathrm{sl}$ st in next sc, leaving 8 -inch length, fasten off. (3 sc)

## LEFT CUFF

Rows 1-31: Rep rows 1-31 of Right Cuff.

## LEFT MITTEN

Rnds 1-13: Rep rnds 1-13 of Right Mitten. (23 sc)
Rnd 14: Ch 3, sk each of next 6 sc (Thumb opening), sc in each of next 17 sc .
Rnd 15: Sc in each of next 3 chs, sc in each of next 17 sc . 20 sc )

Rnd 16: Sc in each sc around.
Rnd 17: Sc in each of next 4 sc , working in back lp , sc in each of next 10 sc (top of hand where Mitten Top will be sewn), sc in both lps of rem 6 sc . $(20 \mathrm{sc}$ )
Rnds 18-21: Sc in each sc around. At the end of rnd 21, sl st in next sc, fasten off.

## LEFT THUMB

Rnd 1 (RS): With size K hook, join highland to same sp as last sc of rnd 14 was worked, ch 1 , sc in same st as beg ch- 1 , sc in each of next 6 sc , sc in same sp as first sc of rnd 14 , sc in opposite side of each of next 3 chs. (11 sc)
Rnds 2-6: Sc in each sc around.
Rnds 7 \& 8: [Sc dec over next $2 \mathrm{sc}]$ around. At the end of rnd 8 , sl st in next sc, leaving 8 -inch length, fasten off. (3 sc)

## MITTEN TOP

Make 2.
Rnd 1: With size M hook and sassy, ch 4 , join in first ch to form a ring, 6 sc in ring.
Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around, join in first sc. (12 sc)
Rnd 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in same sc as beg ch- 1 , sc in next sc, [2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc] around, join in first sc. (18 sc)
Rnd 4: Ch 1 , sc around, inc 2 sc evenly sp around, join in first sc. (20 sc)
Rnds 5-12: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join in first sc.

ATTACH RIGHT MITTEN

Rnd 13: With Right Mitten upside down and Thumb on right, with size M hook, position next sc of Mitten Top to rem front lp
(see Stitch Guide) of rnd 16 of Right Mitten (to left of Thumb), [insert hook through front lp of Mitten and front lp of next sc of Mitten Top, draw up lp and complete a sl st] 10 times, sc in each of next 10 sc of Mitten Top, join in first sc. Fasten off. (10 sl sts, 10 sc )

## ATTACH LEFT MITTEN

Rnd 3: With Left Mitten upside down and Thumb on left, with size M hook, position next sc of rem Mitten Top behind 10th rem front lp of rnd 16 (to left of Thumb), [insert hook through front lp of Mitten and front lp of next sc of Mitten Top, draw up lp and complete a sl st] 10 times, sc in each of next 10 sc of Mitten Top, join in first sc. Fasten off. (10 sl sts, 10 sc )

## FINISHING

Turn Thumb to WS, thread tapestry needle with rem length of yarn, weave through rem sts, gather closed, knot to secure. Fasten off. Turn Thumb to RS; rep for 2nd Thumb.
Fold Cuff to RS of Mitten. With tapestry needle and strand of highland, sew button to center of Cuff on back of Mitten; rep for 2nd Mitten.

# Houndstooth KindleCover 

## 023006 ust

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS
$43 / 4$ inches wide $x 8$ inches long

## MATERIALS

- Aunt Lydia's Classic Crochet size 10 crochet cotton (white: 400 yds per ball; solids: 350 yds per ball):

1 ball each
\#1 white and \#805 blue Hawaii

- Size $7 / 1.65 \mathrm{~mm}$ steel crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Size E/4/3.5mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker


## GAUGE

Size 7 steel hook: 4 dc rnds = 1 inch; $19 \mathrm{dc}=2$ inches

## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.
Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.
Chain-3 at beginning of row or round counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.
Carry color not in use along wrong side of Cover.

## COVER

## BODY

Rnd 1 (RS): Beg at bottom, with size 7 hook and blue Hawaii, ch 44 , dc in 4th ch from hook (3 sk chs count as first dc), dc in each of next 39 chs, 5 dc in last ch, working on opposite side of foundation ch, dc in each of next 39 chs, join (see Pattern Notes) in beg ch-3. ( 88 dc )

Rnd 2: Sl st in next dc, ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), dc in each of next 3 dc , draw up lp of white in last step of 3rd dc, with white, dc in each of next 4 dc, [draw up a lp of blue Hawaii in last step of 4th dc, with blue Hawaii dc in each of next 4 dc , draw up a lp of white in last step of 4th dc, dc in each of the next 4 dc 10 times, join in 3rd ch of beg ch. (11 groups 4-dc blue Hawaii, 11 groups 4-dc white)
Rnd 3: With white, ch 3, dc in each of the next 3 dc , draw up a lp of blue Hawaii in last step of 4th dc, dc in each of next 4 dc , [draw up a lp of white in last step of 4 th dc, dc in each of the next 4 dc , draw up a lp of blue Hawaii in last step of 4th $\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{dc}$ in each of next 4 dc 10 times, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (11 groups 4-dc blue Hawaii, 11 groups 4-dc white)
Rnd 4: With blue Hawaii, ch 3, dc in each of the next 3 dc , draw up a lp of white in last step of 4 th dc , dc in each of next 4 dc , [draw up a lp of blue Hawaii in last step of 4th dc, dc in each of the next 4 dc , draw up a lp of white in last step of 4th dc, dc in
each of next 4 dc$] 10$ times, join in 3rd ch of beg ch-3. (11 groups 4-dc blue Hawaii, 11 groups 4-dc white)
Rnds 5-32: [Rep rnds 3 and 4 alternately] 14 times.
Rnd 33: Rep rnd 3. At the end of rnd 33 , fasten off white, turn.

## FLAP

Row 1 (WS): Ch 3, working in front lp (see Stitch Guide) of each st, dc in each of next 41 sts, turn. ( 42 dc )
Row 2: Ch 3, dc in each dc across, turn.
Row 3: Rep row 2.
Row 4: Ch 2, dc dec (see Stitch Guide) over next 2 dc (2 st dec), dc in each of next 36 dc , dc dec over next 3 dc , turn. ( 38 dc )
Row 5: Ch 2, dc dec over next $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{dc}$ in each of next 14 dc , ch 3 , sk next 3 dc , dc in each of next 15 mdc , dc dec over next 3 dc , turn. ( $31 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sp}$ )
Row 6: Ch 2, dc dec over next 2 dc , dc in each of next 13 dc , dc in each of next 3 chs , dc in each of next 12 dc , dc dec over next 3 dc , turn. ( 30 dc )



Row 7: Ch 2, dc dec over next 2 dc , dc in each of next 24 dc , dc dec over next 3 dc . Fasten off. (26 dc)

## TRIM

Row 8: With size 7 hook, join blue Hawaii in same dc of rnd 33 that Flap row 1 was started,
ch 1, working across Flap, reverse sc (see Stitch Guide) evenly sp across, ending in last st of row 1 of Flap. Fasten off.

## TIE

With size E hook and 1 strand each white and blue Hawaii held tog, leaving a 2 -inch length at
beg, ch 50 , sl st over center 2 sts of rnd 31 , ch 50 , leaving 2 -inch length, fasten off.
Knot each end of Tie and trim ends as desired.
Pass Tie ends through ch-3 sp of Flap, tie ends in a bow.

## Painterly Impressions Hooded Scarf

## SKILL LEVEL



## FINISHED SIZE

$18 \times 57$ inches, including Hood and Ribbing

## MATERIALS

- Lion Brand Tweed Stripes bulky (chunky) weight acrylic yarn ( $3 \mathrm{oz} / 144 \mathrm{yds} / 85 \mathrm{~g}$ per ball): 3 balls \#205 Caribbean
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- 6 -inch cardboard square


## GAUGE

4 V -ts = approximately $31 / 2$ inches; 4 V -st rows = approximately 3 inches

## PATTERN NOTES

Chain-3 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

V-stitch in chain-1 space of indicated V-stitch unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCH

V-stitch (V-st): (Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st or sp.


## HOODED SCARF

## HOOD

Row 1: Ch 63, V-st (see Special Stitch) in 5th ch from hook, *sk next ch, V-st in next ch, rep from * across to last 2 chs, sk next ch, dc in last ch, turn. ( 29 V -sts)
Row 2: Ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), sk next dc, V-st in next V-st (see Pattern Notes), V-st in each rem V-st across, dc in 3rd ch of beg 4 sk chs, turn.
Row 3: Ch 3, sk next dc, V-st in next V-st and in each rem V-st across, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-3.
Rows 4-11: Rep row 3. At end of last row, leaving 20 -inch length, fasten off.

## Ribbing

Row 1: With RS facing, leaving 6 -inch length, join yarn in opposite side of beg ch, ch 9 , sc in 2 nd ch from hook and in each rem ch across, sl st in ch at base of next V-st, turn.
Note: Work rem rows in back lps (see Stitch Guide), unless otherwise stated.

Row 2: Ch 1, working in back lps (see Note), sk sl st, sc in back lp of each of next 8 sc , turn.


Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st across, sl st in ch at base of next V-st, turn.
Next rows: [Rep rows 2 and 3 consecutively] across. At end of last row, leaving 20 -inch length, fasten off.

## Finishing

Using tapestry needle, weave 6 -inch end through row 1 of Ribbing, pull tight to gather, fasten off.
Using tapestry needle, weave 20 -inch length across opposite end of Ribbing, pull tight to gather, fasten firmly but do not fasten off. Fold Ribbing over Hood, using rem 20 -inch length, working from current end across to opposite end, tack Ribbing to Hood in several places across Hood, fasten off at opposite end of Hood. Turn Hood WS out, fold in half, working across opening opposite Ribbing, sew 3 -inch seam, secure end of seam, weave yarn around rem opening, pull tight to gather, fasten off.

## SCARF

Row 1: Ch 23, V-st in 5th ch from hook, *sk next ch, V-st in next ch, rep from * across to last 2 chs, sk next ch, dc in last ch, turn. ( 9 V -sts)
Row 2: Ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), sk next dc, V-st in next V-st (see Pattern Notes), V-st in each rem V-st across, dc in 3rd ch of beg 4 sk chs, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, sk next dc, V-st in next V-st and in each rem V-st across, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-3.
Rows 4-80: Rep row 3. At end of last row, do not fasten off.

## Ribbing

Row 1: Ch 9, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each rem ch across, working across end of Scarf, sl st in next ch-1 sp, turn.
Note: Work rem rows in back lps (see Stitch Guide), unless otherwise stated.
Row 2: Ch 1, working in back lps (see Note) only, sk sl st, sc in back lp of each of next 8 sc , turn.
Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each st across, sl st in ch at base of next V-st, turn.
Next rows: [Rep rows 2 and 3 consecutively] across. At end of last row, leaving 20 -inch length, fasten off.

## ASSEMBLY

Align seam on back of Hood with center of RS of Scarf.
Sew tog.

## TASSEL

Wrap yarn around cardboard square 45 times. Tie separate strand tightly around all lps at 1 end (fold formed), leaving ends long for tying. Remove Tassel from cardboard. Wrap another strand around all lps 1 inch from fold. Cut lps apart at end of Tassel opposite fold. Trim ends even.
Use rem length to sew Tassel to center back of Hood. cw

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Shoe size: 3-4 (7-8 inches) [5-6
(8-9 inches), 7-8 (9-10 inches), 9-10 (10-11 inches), 11-12 (11-12 inches)]

## MATERIALS

- Premier Yarns Deborah Norville Collection Serenity Chunky bulky (chunky) weight acrylic yarn ( $31 / 2 \mathrm{Oz}$ ) $109 \mathrm{yds} / 100 \mathrm{~g}$ per ball):
$2[2,3,3,3]$ \#07 Memphis blues
- Size K/10½/6.5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch markers


## GAUGE

$12 \mathrm{dc}=4$ inches; 13 dc rows $=$ 4 inches

## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.
Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

## SLIPPER

## Make 2.

## CUFF

Row 1: Ch 10, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (9sc)
Row 2: Ch 1, working in back lp (see Stitch Guide), sc in each st across, turn.
Row 3: Rep row 2 for a total of $26[28,30,32,34]$ rows or until

Cuff measures approximately 8 [ $8,9,10,11]$ inches. Holding last row of Cuff to opposite side of foundation ch of row 1 , matching sts, sl st across row to form a tube, do not fasten off.

## LEG

Rnd 1: Ch 1, working in end of Cuff rows, work 24 [26, 28, 32 , 34] sc evenly sp around, join (see Pattern Notes) in beg sc. (24 [26, 28, 32, 34] sc)
Rnd 2: Sc in first sc, sc in each sc around, do not join, place st marker at beg of rnd, move marker as work progresses.
Rnd 3: Ch 1, working in back lp, sc in each st around.
Rep rnd 3 for a total of 28 [ 28 30, 32, 34] rnds or until Slipper measures 8 [ $8,9,9,9]$ inches from top of Cuff.

## HEEL

Row 1: Sc in first sc, place


Row 4: Sk sl st, sc in each sc of previous row, sc in next unworked st on side edge of Slipper, sl st in next st, turn.
Rep row 4 adding 1 st on each row until reaching a total of 19 [21, 23, 25, 29] sc around Slipper including the rem sts on Leg after row 1 of Heel. At end of last row, sl st in next st, do not turn.

## FOOT

Rnd 1: Sc in each of next 19 [21, $23,25,29]$ sc, place st marker (move marker as work progresses). (19 [21, 23, 25, 29] sc)

Rnd 2: Sc in each sc around.
Rep rnd 2 until Foot measures $61 / 2\left[71 / 2,8^{1 ⁄ 2}, 91 / 2,101 / 2\right]$ inches from Heel.

## TOE SHAPING

Note: Leaving st marker from Foot in place, place another st marker at each side edge of Foot, move st markers with each rnd to keep them at each side edge of Foot.
Rnd 1: Sc to within 2 sc of first marker, sc dec (see Stitch Guide) in next 2 sts, sc in next sc, sc dec in next 2 sc, sc across to within 2 sts of 2 nd marker, sc dec in next 2 sc , sc in next sc, sc dec in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in each rem sc of rnd. ( 15 [17, 19, 21, 25] sc)
Rnds 2-4: Sc in each sc around.
Rnd 5: Sc to within 2 sc of first marker, sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in next sc, sc dec in next 2 sc , sc across to within 2 sts of 2 nd marker, sc dec in next 2 sc , sc in next sc, sc dec in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ in each rem sc of rnd. ( $11[13,15$, 17, 21] sc)
Rnd 6: Sc in each sc around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Turn Slipper inside out, fold Toe flat across and with tapestry needle and length of yarn, sew Toe opening closed.



## PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.
Do not join rounds unless otherwise stated. Use stitch marker to mark rounds.

Cut hook-and-loop tape in half lengthwise, creating two $11 / 2 \times$ 5/16-inch pieces.

## MITTENS

Make 2.

## CUFF

Row 1: Ch 10, working in back bar of ch (see illustration), sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (9 sc)


Back Bar of Chain

Rows 2-21: Ch 1, working in back lp (see Stitch Guide) of each sc, sc in each st across, turn.
Row 22: Holding row 21 to opposite side of foundation ch,
working through both thicknesses in back lp of sts of row 21 and front lps of foundation ch, sl st across, do not fasten off.

## MITTEN

Rnd 1: Working in edge of rows of Cuff, ch 1 , sc in end of each row around, do not join rnds, place st marker and move as work progresses. (21 sc)
Note: Work in back lp only of each sc unless otherwise stated.

Rnd 2: Sc in each st around.
Rnds 3-7: Rep rnd 2.
Rnd 8: [2 sc in next sc] twice, sc in each rem st around. (23 sc)
Rnd 9: Rep rnd 8. (25 sc)
Rnd 10: Ch 4, sk next 3 sts (thumb opening), sc in each of next 22 sc . (22 sc, ch-4 sp)
Rnd 11: Sc in each of next 4 chs, sc in each of next 22 sc . ( 26 sc )
Rnds 12-18: Rep rnd 2.
Rnd 19: [Sc dec (see Stitch Guide) in next 2 sc$]$ twice, sc in each of next 22 sc . (24 sc)

## Left Mitten

Note: Position Mitten flat with 12 sts on top (back) of hand and 12 sts on bottom (palm), sc across to last st of top (back) of hand. Thumb opening will be on right edge of mitten.
Rnd 20: Sc in next st, ch 9 (underside of fingers), sk next 9 sts, sc in each of next 14 sts. ( 15 sc, ch-9 sp)
Rnd 21: [Sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in each of next 10 sts$]$ twice. ( 22 sc )
Rnd 22: [Sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in each of next 9 sts] twice. ( 20 sc )
Rnd 23: [Sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in each of next 8 sts] twice. ( 18 sc )
Rnd 24: [Sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in each of next 7 sts] twice. (16 sc)
Rnd 25: [Sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in each of next 6 sts] twice. ( 14 sc )
Rnd 26: [Sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in each of next 5 sts] twice. (12 sc)
Rnd 27: [Sc dec in next 2 sts, sc in each of next 4 sts$]$ twice. ( 10 sc )
Fold rnd 27, flat across, working through both thicknesses, sl st in each of next 5 sts. Fasten off.

## Right Mitten

Note: Position Mitten flat with 12 sts on top (back) of hand and 12 sts on bottom (palm), sc across to last st of hand on same edge as thumb. Thumb opening will be on left edge of mitten.

Rnd 20: Sc in each of next 14 sc (top of fingers), ch 9 , sk next 9 sts (underside of fingers), sc in next st. (15 sc, ch-9 sp)


Rnd 25: [Sc in each of next
6 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts] twice. (14 sc)
Rnd 26: [Sc in each of next
5 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts] twice. (12 sc)
Rnd 27: [Sc in each of next 4 sts, sc dec in next 2 sts] twice. (10 sc)
Fold rnd 27, flat across, working through both thicknesses, sl st in each of next 5 sts. Fasten off.

## Finger Opening Trim

Row 1: Sl st in same sp as last sc before ch sp on rnd 20, ch 2 , working in sk sts of rnd 19, dc in back lp of each of next 9 sts, sl st in ch sp of rnd 20 directly above last dc. Fasten off.
Rep row 1 of Finger Opening Trim on rem Mitten.

Thumb
Make 2.
Rnd 1: Sl st in first sk st of rnd 9 , working in back lps only, sc in same sc, sc in next 2 sc , sc in side edge of st between rnds 9 and 10 , sc in each of next 4 chs, sc in side edge of st between rnds 9 and 10. ( 9 sc )
Rnds 2-5: Working in back lps, sc in each st around. At the end of rnd 5 , sl st in next st, fasten off.

## FINISHING

With sewing needle and thread, sew hook-and-loop tape to Finger Opening Trim and to inside edge of rnd 21 of Mitten.

## SKILL LEVEL

$\square$ Intermediate

## FINISHED SIZE

Approximately $21 / 4 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ inches, excluding ear wire and bead

## MATERIALS

- Kreinik Very Fine (\#4) Braid metallic thread ( 12 yds per spool):

1 spool \#3231 moonstone

- Size $8 / 1.50 \mathrm{~mm}$ steel crochet hook
- $3 / 4$-inch plastic rings: 2
- $6 \times 13 \mathrm{~mm}$ crystal teardrop beads: 2
- Silver French hook ear wires: 2
- Stringing needle or collapsible eye needle
- Sewing needle
- Craft glue


## GAUGE

Gauge is not important for this project.

## PATTERN NOTES

Chain-3 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Chain-4 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet and chain 1 unless otherwise stated.

## EARRING

## Make 2.

BASE
Rnd 1: String 1 bead on braid and working around plastic ring, 45 sc around ring (see illustration), join with sl st in first st.

## Do not fasten off.



## Single Crochet Around Ring

## PINEAPPLE

Row 1: Ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), dc in each of next 13 sc , leaving rem sc sts unworked, turn. (14dc)

Row 2: Ch 4 (see Pattern Notes), [dc, ch 1] in each of next 13 sts, turn. ( $14 \mathrm{dc}, 13 \mathrm{ch}-1 \mathrm{sps}$ )
Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first ch-1 sp, [ch 3, sc in next ch-1 sp] 12 times, turn. ( $13 \mathrm{sc}, 12 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$ )
Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first ch-3 sp , [ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp] 11 times, turn. (12 sc, $11 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$ )
Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first ch-3 sp , [ch 3 , sc in next ch-3 sp] 10 times, turn. (11 sc, $10 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$ )
Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first ch-3 sp, [ch 3 , sc in next ch-3 sp] 9 times, turn. (10 sc, 9 ch-3 sps)
Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first ch-3 sp, [ch 3 , sc in next ch -3 sp ] 8 times, turn. (9 sc, 8 ch-3 sps)

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in first ch-3 sp, [ch 3 , sc in next ch -3 sp ] 7 times, turn. ( $8 \mathrm{sc}, 7 \mathrm{ch}-3 \mathrm{sps}$ )
Row 9: Ch 1, sc in first ch-3 sp, [ch 3 , sc in next ch- 3 sp] 6 times, turn. (7 sc, 6 ch-3sps)
Row 10: Ch 1, sc in first ch-3 sp, [ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp] 5 times, turn. (6 sc, 5 ch-3 sps)
Row 11: Ch 1, sc in first ch-3 sp, [ch 3 , sc in next ch-3 sp] 4 times, turn. (5 sc, 4 ch-3 sps)
Row 12: Ch 1, sc in first ch-3 sp,
[ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp] 3 times, turn. (4 sc, 3 ch-3 sps)
Row 13: Ch 1 , sc in first ch- 3 sp , [ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp] twice, turn. (3 sc, 2 ch-3 sps)
Row 14: Ch 1, sc in first ch-3 sp, ch 1 , draw up bead, ch 1 tightly around bead, ch 1 , sc in next ch-3 sp. Fasten off. (2 sc, 2 ch sps)

## FINISHING

To prevent fraying, weave in end and dab with glue.
Attach earring wire at top (opposite Pineapple). Block lightly.

- Universal Classic Worsted medium (worsted) weight acrylic/wool yarn ( 3 ¹⁄20z/197 yds/ 100g per skein):
2 skeins \#647 flannel
- Sizes $\mathrm{G} / 6 / 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ and $\mathrm{H} / 8 / 5 \mathrm{~mm}$ crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Black size large Boye Suede Mitten Palms
- Lanyard hooks: 2
- Stitch markers


## MATERIALS FOR MOM

- Universal Classic Worsted medium (worsted) weight acrylic/wool yarn ( $31 / 20 z / 197 \mathrm{yds} / 100 \mathrm{~g}$ per skein):

- Round elastic cord: 2 pieces each 6 inches in length or circumference size of wrist
- Lanyard hooks: 2
- Stitch markers

- Trinkets, charms or beads: 3
- Lanyard hooks: 2

## PATTERN NOTES

Work in continuous rounds, do not turn or join unless otherwise stated.
Mark first stitch of round. Move marker up with each round.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.
Chain-2 at beginning of rows counts as first back post double crochet unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCH FOR DAD'S

## Front post single crochet decrease

(fpsc dec): Insert hook in next st, yo, pull lp through, insert hook around post of next st, yo, pull Ip through, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

## SPECIAL STITCHES FOR MOM'S

Leg single crochet (leg sc): Resembles knitting when worked in continuous rnds, insert hook between legs of st (2 vertical bars at base of st), yo, pull Ip through, yo, pull through all Ips on hook.
2-stitch decrease (2-st dec): Insert hook around post of next st, yo, pull Ip through, insert hook between legs of next st, yo, pull Ip through, insert hook around post of next st, yo, pull Ip through, yo, pull Ip through all lps on hook.



SPECIAL STITCH FOR CHILD'S
Slip stitch decrease (sl st dec): Insert hook in front lp (see Stitch Guide) of each of next 2 sts, yo, pull lp through sts and Ip on hook.

## Make 2.

## Palm

Rnd 1 (RS): With size $H$ hook, ch 36, being careful not to twist ch, sl st in first ch to form ring, ch 1 , sc in same ch as joining and in each ch around, do not join (see Pattern Notes), mark first st of rnd (see Pattern Notes). (36 sc)
Rnd 2: *[Sc in next st, fpsc (see Stitch Guide) around next st] twice, sc in next st, fpsc around same st as last sc, rep from * around to last st, sc in last st. (43 sts)
Rnd 3: [Fpsc around next st, sc in next st] around to last st, fpsc around last st.
Rnd 4: [Sc in next st, fpsc around next st] around to last st, sc in last st.
Rnds 5-8: [Rep rnds 3 and 4 alternately] twice.

Rnd 9: Rep rnd 3.

## Fingers

Rnd 1: Ch 4 (thumb crossing ch), sk next 10 sts, [sc in next st, fpsc around next st] 16
times, sc in last st. (33 sts, 4 chs)

Rnd 2: Sc in each of next 4 crossing chs,
[fpsc around next st, sc in next st] 16 times, fpsc around last st. ( 37 sts )
Rnd 3: [Sc in next st, fpsc around next st] around to last st, sc in last st.
Rnd 4: [Fpsc around next st, sc in next st] around to last st, fpsc around last st.

Rnds 5-16: [Rep rnds 3 and 4 alternately] 6 times.
Rnd 17: Rep rnd 3.
Rnd 18: Fpsc around next st, $s c$ in next st, fpsc around next st, *fpsc dec (see Special Stitch) twice, sc in next st, fpsc around next $s t^{* *}$, sc in next st, fpsc around next st, rep from * around to last 4 sts, ending last rep at **, fpsc dec twice. (27 sts)

Rnd 19: Rep rnd 4.
Rnd 20: Fpsc around next st, [sc in next st, fpsc around next st, 2 fpsc dec] 4 times, sc in next st, fpsc around last st. (19 sts)
Rnd 21: [Sc in next st, fpsc around next st, 2 fpsc dec] 3 times, sc in last st. Leaving long end, fasten off. (13 sts)
Weave long end through top of sts on last rnd, pull tight to close. Secure end.

## Thumb

Rnd 1 (RS): With size H hook and RS of Mitten facing, join (see Pattern Notes) in first fpsc on opening, ch 1, sc in same st as joining, [fpsc around next st, sc in next st] 4 times, fpsc around next st, sc dec (see Stitch Guide) in corner and first thumb crossing ch, sc in each of next 3 crossing chs, sc in corner, do not join. (15 sts)
Rnd 2: [Fpsc around next st, sc in next st] around to last st, fpsc around last st.
Rnd 3: [Sc in next st, fpsc around next st] around to last st, sc in last st.

Rnds 4-9: [Rep rnds 2 and 3 alternately] 3 times.
Rnd 10: Fpsc around next st, [sc in next st, fpsc around next st, 2 fpsc dec] around to last 2 sts, sc in next st, fpsc around last st. (11 sts)
Rnd 11: Rep rnd 3.
Rnd 12: Fpsc around next st, fpsc dec 5 times. Leaving long end, fasten off. ( 6 sts)
Weave end through sts on last rnd, pull tight to close. Secure end.

## Cuff

Rnd 1: With size $G$ hook and RS of Mitten facing, join in beg ch- 36 on Palm, ch 2 (see Pattern Notes), working sts around post of sc on rnd 1 of Palm, [fpdc (see Stitch Guide) around next st, bpdc (see Stitch Guide) around next st] around to last st, fpdc around last st, join (see Pattern Notes) in 2nd ch of beg ch-2. ( 36 sts)
Rnd 2: Ch 2, [fpdc around next st, bpdc around next st] around to last st, fpdc around last st, join in 2nd ch of beg ch-2.
Rnds 3-8: [Rep rnd 2] 6 times. At end of last rnd, fasten off.


## Finishing

Following manufacturer's instructions on package, sew Suede Mitten Palm on Mitten.
Attach lanyard hook near Cuff on side of Mitten farthest from thumb.

## MOM'S MITTENS

## Make 2.

## Preparation

Overlap elastic ends $1 / 2$ inch, sew in place, forming ring.

## Cuff

Row 1: With size G hook and wood violet, ch 11 , sl st in back $\mathbf{~ p}$ (see Stitch Guide) of 2nd ch from hook and in back Ip of each ch across, turn. (10 s/ sts)

Row 2: Sl st in back Ip of each sl st across, turn.
Rows 3-38: [Rep row 2] 36 times. At end of last row, leaving long end for sewing, fasten off.
Sew first and last rows tog.

## Palm

Rnd 1 (RS): With size H hook and purple allure, join (see Pattern Notes) in end of row on Cuff, ch 1, working over elastic ring (see illustration), sc in end of each row on Cuff, do not join (see Pattern Notes), mark first st of rnd (see Pattern Notes). (38 sts)

Rnd 2: [Leg sc (see Special Stitches) in next st, fpsc (see Stitch Guide) around next st] around.

Rnds 3-10: [Rep rnd 2] 8 times.

## Fingers

Rnd 1: Leg sc in next st, ch 3 (thumb crossing ch), sk next 9 sts, [leg sc in next st, fpsc around next st] 14 times. (29 sts, 3 chs)
Rnd 2: Leg sc in next st, sc in each of the next 3 crossing chs, [leg sc in next st, fpsc around next st] 14 times. ( 32 sts)

Rnd 3: [Leg sc in next st, fpsc around next st] around.

Rnds 4-16: [Rep rnd 3] 13 times.
Rnd 17: *Leg sc in next st, 2-st dec (see Special Stitches), [leg sc in next st, fpsc around next st] twice, rep from * around. (24 sts)

Rnds 18 \& 19: [Rep rnd 3] twice.
Rnd 20: [Leg sc in next st, 2-st dec, leg sc in next $s t$, fpsc around next st] around. (16 sts)

Rnd 21: Rep rnd 3. Leaving long end, fasten off.

Weave long end through sts on last rnd, pull tight to close. Secure end.

## Thumb

Rnd 1 (RS): With size H hook and purple allure, with RS of Mitten facing, join (see Pattern Notes) in first leg sc on opening, ch 1, leg sc in same st as joining, [fpsc around next st, leg sc in next st] 3 times, fpsc around next st, sc dec (see Stitch Guide) in corner and first thumb crossing ch, sc in next ch, sc dec in last crossing ch and corner, fpsc around next st, do not join. (12 sts)
Rnd 2: [Leg sc in next st, fpsc around next st] around.

Rnds 3-10: [Rep rnd 2] 8 times.
Rnd 11: [Leg sc in next st, 2-st dec, leg sc in next st, fpsc around next st] twice. (8 sts)

Rnd 12: Rep rnd 2. Leaving long end, fasten off. Weave long end through sts on last rnd, pull tight to close. Secure end.

## Ruffle

With RS facing and size H hook, join iris orchid in end of row on Cuff, ch $1,[(s c, c h 2, d c)$ in end of row, sk end of next row] around, join in beg sc. Fasten off. (19 Ruffles)

## Finishing

Attach Lanyard hook near Cuff on side of Mitten farthest from thumb.

## CHILD'S MITTENS

## Make 2.

## Preparation

Overlap elastic ends $1 / 2$ inch, sew in place forming ring.

## Cuff

Row 1: With size G hook and white, ch 7 [8], sl st in back lp (see Stitch Guide) of 2nd ch from hook and in back Ip of each ch across, turn. (6 [7] s/ sts)
Row 2: SI st in back Ip of each sl st across, turn.
Rows 3-32 [3-35]: [Rep row 2] 30 [33] times. At end of last row, leaving long end for sewing, fasten off.
Sew first and last rows tog.

## Palm

Rnd 1 (RS): With size I hook, join (see Pattern Notes) Easter surprise in end of row on Cuff, working over elastic ring (see illustration), sl st in end of each row on Cuff working last sl st in same sp as joining, do not join (see Pattern Notes), mark first st (see Pattern Notes). (32 [35] sl sts)

Rnd 2: SI st in front Ip (see Stitch Guide) of each sl st around.
Rnds 3-7 [3-9]: [Rep rnd 2] 5 [7] times.

## Fingers

Rnd 1: Ch 2 [3] (thumb crossing ch), sk next 7 sts, sl st in front lp of each sl st around. (25 [28] sl sts, 2 [3] chs)
Rnd 2: SI st in front Ip of each of next 2 [3] crossing chs, sl st in front lp of each sl st around. (27 [31] slsts)
Rnd 3: SI st in front Ip of each sl st around.
Rnds 4-11 [4-13]: [Rep rnd 3] 8 [10] times.
Rnd 12 [14]: SI st in front Ip of next 0 [1] sl $\mathrm{st}(\mathrm{s}),{ }^{*} \mathrm{sl}$ st in front lp of each of next 7 [8] sl sts, sl st dec (see Special Stitch), rep from * around. ( 24 [28] s/sts)

Rnd 13 [15]: Rep rnd 3.
Rnd 14 [16]: *SI st in front Ip of each of next 4 [5] sl sts, sl st dec, rep from * around. (20 [24] s/sts)

Rnd 15 [17]: Rep rnd 3.
Rnd 16 [18]: *SI st in front Ip of each of next 2 [1] sl st(s), sl st dec, rep from * around. Leaving long end, fasten off. ( 15 [16] s/ sts)
Weave long end through front Ip of sts on last rnd, pull tight to close. Secure end.

## Thumb

Rnd 1 (RS): With size I hook and RS of Mitten
facing, join Easter surprise in front $\mid \mathrm{p}$ of first sl st on opening, s st in front Ip of each of next 6 $s \mid s t s, s 1 s t$ in corner, $s \mid s t$ in each thumb crossing ch, sly st in corner, $s l$ st in same sp as joining, do not join. (11 [12] s/sts)
Rad 2: SI st in front Ip of each of first 6 sl sss, sl st dec, si st in front lp of 0 [1] slst(s), si st dec, $s l s t$ in front lp of last $s \mid s t$. (9 (10] $s / s t s)$
Rad 3 : SI st in front Ip of each si st around.
Rods 4-6 [4-8]: [Rep rind 3] 3 [5] times.

Rad 7 [9]: SI st in front Ip of next 0 [1] sI $s t(s)$, $[\mathrm{s} \mid \mathrm{st}$ in front lp of next $\mathrm{s}|\mathrm{st}, \mathrm{s}| \mathrm{st}$ dec] around. Leaving long end, fasten off. (6 [7] slots)
Weave long end through front Ip of sss on last ind, pull tight to close. Secure end.

## Finishing

Sew trinkets to center top of Mitten near Cuff as shown in photo.
Attach Lanyard hook near Cuff on side of Mitten farthest from thumb.
