## Here is what you will need to make this pattern:

Materials:

- yarn I used
- Alize Diva in white, green, beige, blue, violet, grey, yellow, off-white, saffron, Burgundy and brown.
- DMC threads to embroider his shorts.
- 1.75 mm crochet hook.
- tapestry needle to sew in the ends
- scissors
- Fiber
- plastic animation eyes (you can find it on eBay)

Finished size approx. 30 cm (12" inches) using the materials stated in the pattern.

## Abbreviations:

Sc - single crochet
HDC - half double crochet
sl st - slip stitch
ch - chain
sk - skip stitch
FL - work Front loop

BL - work back loop

MC - magic circle
FPDC - front post double crochet stitch.
FPSC - front post single crochet
Dec - single crochet two together (invisible decrease)
Invisible decrease:
Put hook through the FRONT LOOPS only of two consecutive stitches (two loops on hook) yarn over pull through both loops. (two loops on hook) yarn over pull through two loops.

## Notes:

1. Working in continues rounds, use a thread as a marker.
2. When making toys, you should use a much smaller hook than recommended for the yarn you have chosen.
3. Make sure you crochet tight enough; otherwise, the stuffing will show through the holes.
4. Starting with legs to head as one piece. yaaay! I know you are happy now, you will sew just the head.


Let's start our pattern with making his arms to attach it to his body while we are working.


## Fingers (make 8)

With skin color
Rnd 1: 6 sc into the MC ( 6 sts)
Rn 2-4: 6 scs ( 6 sts)

## Hand:

With skin color
Rnd 1: joining his fingers like this, 3sc form $1^{\text {st }}$ finger, 3sc from his $2^{\text {nd }}$ finger, 6 sc from his $3^{\text {rd }}$ finger, $3 s c$ from his $2^{\text {nd }}$ finger, 3 sc from his $1^{\text {st }}$ finger. ( 18 sts)


Rnd 2-4: 18 scs (18 sts)
Rnd 5:
Right hand: 6 scs, 3 sc from his $4^{\text {th }}$ finger (thumb), 9 scs ( 18 sts) Left hand: $10 \mathrm{scs}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ from his $4^{\text {th }}$ finger (thumb), 5 scs ( 18 sts)
Rnd 6: 18 scs (18 sts)
Rnd 7: (sc, sc2tog) 6 times (12 sts)
Rnd 8-10: 12 scs (12 sts)
Rnd 11: (sc inc, 5sc) 2 times (14 sts)
Rnd 12: 14 scs (14 sts)
Rnd 13: sc, sc inc, 6 scs, sc inc, 5 scs (16 sts)


Rnd 14-18: 16 scs (16 sts)
Rnd 19: (6 sc, sc2tog) 2 times (14 sts)
Rnd 20: 14 scs (14 sts)
Rnd 21: ( $6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} \mathrm{inc}$ ) 2 times ( 16 sts )
Rnd 22: 16 scs (16 sts)
Rnd 23: ( $7 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} \mathrm{inc}$ ) 2 times ( 18 sts )
Rnd 24-29: 18 scs (18 sts)
Fasten off!



## Head:

With skin color

Rnd 1: 6 sc into the MC ( 6 sts)
Rnd 2: (sc inc) 6 times (12 sts)
Rnd 3: (sc, sc inc) 6 times ( 18 sts)
Rnd 4: ( $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ inc) 6 times ( 24 sts )
Rnd 5: ( $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ inc) 6 times ( 30 sts )
Rnd 6: ( $4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ inc) 6 times ( 36 sts )
Rnd 7: ( $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ inc) 6 times ( 42 sts )
Rnd 8: ( $6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ inc) 6 times ( 48 sts )
Rnd 9: ( $7 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc}$ inc) 6 times ( 54 sts )
Rnd 10-19: 54 scs ( 54 sts )
Rnd 20: 9sc, 6 sc inc, 6sc, 6 sc inc, 27 sc ( 66 sts)
Rnd 21-23: 66 scs ( 66 sts)
Rnd 24: (9sc, sc2tog) 6 times ( 60 sts)

Rnd 25: (8sc, sc2tog) 6 times ( 54 sts )
Rnd 26: (7sc, sc2tog) 6 times ( 48 sts )
Rnd 27: 48 scs (48 sts)
Rnd 28: (6sc, sc2tog) 6 times (42 sts)
Rnd 29: (5sc, sc2tog) 6 times ( 36 sts )
Rnd 30: (4sc, sc2tog) 6 times (30 sts)
Rnd 31: (3sc, sc2tog) 6 times ( 24 sts )
Rnd 32: (2sc, sc2tog) 6 times (18 sts)
Rnd 33: 18 sc (18 sts)
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing!


## Ears:

With skin color
Rnd 1: 6 scs into the MC (6 sts)
Fasten off!
You can sew it or glue it with fiber glue as I did.

I bought them from Ebay

## Mouth:

Embroider with rose color a few sts on same place, then add white just 2 more times.

## Hair:

"simply you will make a ch of 48 including a piece of yarn in every ch you make"
Ch 48


Rnd1: 5sc, sc2tog, repeat till the end of the rnd. (42 sts)
Rnd 2: 4sc, sc2tog, repeat till the end of the rnd. ( 36 sts )
Rnd 3: 3sc, sc2tog, repeat till the end of the rnd. (30 sts)
Rnd4: 2sc, sc2tog, repeat till the end of the rnd. ( 24 sts )
Rnd 5: sc, sc2tog, repeat till the end of the rnd. (18sts)
Rnd 6: 6 sc2tog (12 sts)
Rnd 7: 3 sc2tog (6 sts)
Fasten off. Then sewing the wig to the doll (to the last increase rnd. If you would love to see how I made the hair \& facial, join our FB group here

Rnd 1: working from the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from your hook, inc, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ inc in the last ch, working on the opposite side, 2 sc , inc ( 12 sts )
Rnd 2: sc, inc, 2sc, (inc) 4 times, 2 sc, inc, sc (18 sts)
Rnd 3: 8sc, (inc) 2 times, 8 sc ( 20 sts )
Rnd 4: 9 sc , (inc) 2times, 9 sc ( 22 sts )
Rnd 5: 10 sc , (inc) 2times, 10 sc ( 24 sts )
Rnd 6: 11sc, (inc) 2times, 11 sc (26)
Rnd 7-14: 26 sc (26)
Rnd 15: 3sc, dec, 5 sc, dec, 14 sc (24 sts)
Rnd 16: dec, 10 sc , dec, 10 sc ( 22 sts)


Rnd 17: sc, ch10, sk 10, 11sc (12 sts)
Rnd 18: 22 sc ( 22 sts )
Rnd 19: dec, 8sc, 2 dec, 6 sc , dec (18 sts)

Fasten off!

Rnd 1-14: same as the right one
Rnd 15: 15 sc , dec, 5 sc , dec, 2 sc ( 24 sts )
Rnd 16: sc, dec, 10 sc , dec, 9 sc (22 sts)
Note: sl st twice Because I want to start rnd 17 from the $3^{\text {rd }}$ st
Rnd 17: 11 sc, ch10, sk 10, sc (12 sts)
Rnd 18-29: same as the right one

## Legs:

skin color
Right leg: attach yarn to the $3^{\text {rd }}$ st before the sl st of last rnd of the right socks
Left leg: attach yarn to the $3^{\text {rd }}$ st before the sl st of last rnd of the right socks

Rnd 30: working blo, 22sc (22 sts)


Rnd 31: 22 sc (22 sts)
Rnd 32: inc, 21 sc ( 23 sts)
Rnd 33: 23 sc ( 23 sts )
Rnd 34: inc, 22 sc (24 sts)
Rnd 35: 24 sc ( 24 sts )
Rnd 36: sc, inc, 22 sc (25 sts)
Rnd 37: sc, inc, 23 sc (26 sts)
Rnd 38-44: 26 sc (26 sts)
Rnd 45: 2sc, dec, 22 sc ( 25 sts)
Rnd 46: (dec) 3times, 8sc, 3 inc, 8 sc ( 25 sts)
Rnd 47: sc, inc, 23 sc (26 sts)

SI st, cut the yarn

Make the $2^{\text {nd }}$ leg the same way then fasten off!

Rnd 63: attach yarn to the $1^{\text {st }} \operatorname{leg},\left(14^{\text {th }}\right.$ st before the $s l$ st), ch2, $s c$ in the $2^{\text {nd }} \operatorname{leg}\left(3^{\text {rd }}\right.$ st before the sl st ), 31 sc (from the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{leg}$ ) 2 sc (from the ch2) 32 sc (from the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{leg}$ ) 2 sc (from the ch2) $(32+2+32+2=68$ sts $)$

If this way doesn't work and the legs are twisted, you will look for the midpoint of both legs and then you make the union there. Because not all crochet with the same tension and that can affect the union

Rnd 9: $60 \mathrm{sc}(60 \mathrm{sts})$
Rnd 10: (8sc, dec) 6 times ( 54 sts )
Rnd 11: 54 sc (54 sts)

Rnd 12: (7sc, dec) 6 times ( 48 sts )
Rnd 13: ( $6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) 6 times ( 42 sts )
Rnd 14: 20 sc , dec, sc, dec, 17 sc ( 40 sts )
Rnd 15-23: 40 sc ( 40 sts)
Rnd 24: (4sc, inc) 8 times ( 48 sts )
Joining arms to the body
Rnd 25: 12sc, ( 6 sc of the arm, starting from (the $5^{5 \text { th }}$ st after the $s l$ st) 19 sc , ( 6 sc of the arm), 5sc (48 sts)
Note: when making the 6sc of the arm you will insert your hook through the 6 sts of the body too
Rnd 26: 12sc, (12 sc of the arm), 19 sc , ( 12 sc of the arm), 5 sc ( 60 sts )
Rnd 27: 11 sc , dec, 10 sc , dec, 17 sc , dec, 8sc, dec, 4 sc (56 sts)
Rnd 28: 11sc, dec, 8sc, dec, 17 sc , dec, 8sc, dec, 4 sc (52 sts)
Rnd 29: 10 sc , dec, 8 sc , dec, 15 sc , dec, 8 sc , dec, 3sc (48 sts)
Rnd 30: 9sc, dec, 8 sc , dec, 13 sc , dec, 8 sc , dec, 2 sc ( 44 sts )
Rnd 31: 8 sc , dec, 8 sc , dec, 11 sc , dec, 8 sc , dec, sc (40 sts)
Rnd 32: (6sc, dec) 5 times ( 35 sts )
Rnd 33: ( $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) 5 times ( 30 sts )
Rnd 34: 8 sc , (dec) 4 times, 8 sc , (dec) 3 times (23 sts)
Rnd 35: 7sc, (dec) 3 times, 6 sc , (dec) twice (18 sc)
Rnd 36-37: 18 sc (18 sts)
Fasten off, leaving long tail to sew Body to the head.

## Sneakers:

Sole (make 2 with white color, 2 with grey color)
Ch 16
Rnd 1: sc in $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}$ from hook, sc in next 10 chs , hdc in next 2 chs, 2hdc in the next ch, 5 hdc in the last ch, (working on the opposite side) 2 hdc in the next ch, hdc in the next 2 chs , sc in the next $10 \mathrm{chs}, \mathrm{sc}$ inc in the last $\mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sl}$ st to the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{st}$ ( 36 sts )


Rnd 5: ch1, 26 hdc, change color to white, 13 sc, working blo 6 sc , back to working in both loops, 13 sc , sl st to the $1^{\text {st }}$ st (58 sts)
Change color to burgundy
Rnd 6: ch1, 58 sc ( 58 sts )
Rnd 7: ch1, 33 sc , dec, 2sc, dec, 6sc, dec, 2sc, dec, 7sc, sl st to the $1^{\text {st }}$ st ( 54 sts )
Rnd 8: ch1, $34 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 8 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 8 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sl}$ st to the $1^{\text {st }}$ st (52 sts)
Rnd 9: ch1, 31 sc , dec, 2sc, dec, 4sc, dec, 2sc, dec, 5sc, sl st to the $1^{\text {st }}$ st ( 48 sts )
Rnd 10: ch1, $34 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 8 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sl}$ st to the $1^{\text {st }}$ st (46 sts)
Cut the yarn, fasten off
Rnd 11: using white color, start at the $3^{\text {rd }}$ st from the previous $s l$ st, ch1, $30 \mathrm{sc},(\mathrm{dec}, \mathrm{sc})$ twice, dec, $8 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sl}$ st to the $1^{\text {st }}$ st ( 43 sts )
Rnd 12: ch1, 24sc.
Cut the yarn, fasten off
Rnd 13: from the center of the heel, using yellow color, ch1, 12 sc, ch1, work on rnd 11, sk sc, sc, ch1, sk1, sc, ch1, sk1, $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1, \mathrm{sk} 1, \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1, \mathrm{sk} 1, \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1, \mathrm{sk} 1$, continue working in rnd $12,12 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sl}$ st to the $1^{\text {st }}$ st ( 36 sts )

## Tongue:

## With white

Leaving long tail, make 9 chs
Row 1: sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, 7 sc , ch1 and turn ( 8 sts )
Row 2: 4sc, inc, 3 sc , ch1 and turn ( 9 sts)
Row 3: 9 sc , ch1 and turn ( 9 sts )
Row 4: 4sc, inc, 4sc, ch1 and turn (10 sts)
Row5: 10 sc , ch1 and turn (10 sts)
Row 6-9: working blo, 10 sc , ch1 and turn (10 sts)


## Toe details:

On front loop of Rnd 5 of the shoes, attach yellow yarn to the $1^{\text {st }} s t$, leaving long tail first.
Row 1: ch1, 6 sc , ch1 and turn ( 6 sts )
Row 2: 6 sc, ch1 and turn ( 6 sts)
Row 3: sk 1, 4 sc , sl st to the last st (4 sts)
Fasten off!

Sew it as pictures!
By the way, I used glue and then I pulled the loops inside and made a couple of knots.

## Doubled Sole:

Cut piece of cardboard and put it between!


## Pants:

Ch60, close it with a sl st
Rnd 1: ch1, (doesn't count as a st) dc in each ch around, sl st to the $1^{\text {st }}$ st, ch1 and turn your work to the wrong side. ( 60 sts)

Rnd 2: working in FLO, hdc in each st, sl st (60 sts)
Rnd 3-9: ch1, hdc in each st around, don't sl st (60 sts)


Rnd 10: ch4, hdc in the next 30 sts, hdc in each of the ch4, sl st to the $1^{\text {st }}$ st. (34 sts)


Rnd 11-17: hdc in each st around, don't sl st. (34 sts)


For $2^{\text {nd }}$ leg of the pants:
Rnd 10: attach yarn to any st, and repeat rnds 11-17.
Note: you will work on the same ch4 of the $1^{\text {st }}$ leg, you will put your hdc there.


Turn your work the wrong side again. So you will have your $1^{\text {st }}$ rnd is the right side of your work.

## Pockets:

Ch 9, working from 2nd ch from hook.
Row 1: sc in each st across, ch1 and turn (8 sts)
Row 2-3: sc in each st across, ch1 and turn (8 sts)
Row 4: dec, 6 sc, ch1 and turn (7 sts)
Row 5: 5sc, dec, ch1 and turn (6 sts)
Row 6: dec, 4 sc, ch1 and turn (5 sts)

Row 7: 3sc, dec, ch1 and turn (4 sts)

## Edging the whole piece.

Right pocket: ch1 and turn sc in each st, then start your edging around, sl st to the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$.

Left pocket: starting edging from the side rows, and finish with sc in each st of the last row, sl st to the $1^{\text {st }}$ st.


Attach pocket with DMC brown color like the picture below, and make a ch of 70 with brown yarn, and attach it as his belt also like the picture below.


## Shirt:

With black yarn
Ch 27, starting from the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook.
Row 1: 4sc, (ch3), (6sc, ch3) 3 times, 4 sc, ch1 and turn (26 sts)
Row 2: 4sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc) \{6sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc)\} 3 times, 4sc, ch1 and turn (34 sts)


Row 3: 5sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc) \{8sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc) \} 3 times, 5sc, ch1 and turn ( 42 sts )

Row 4: 6sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc) \{10sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc) \} 3 times, 6sc, ch1 and turn ( 50 sts)
Row 5: 7sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc) \{12sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc) \} 3 times, 7 sc , ch1 and turn ( 58 sts )
Row 6: 8sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc) \{14sc, in ch3 make ( $\mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 3, \mathrm{sc}$ ) $\}$ 3 times, 8 sc , ch1 and turn ( 66 sts )
Row 7: 9sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc) \{16sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc) \} 3 times, 9 sc , ch1 and turn ( 74 sts )

Row 8: 10sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc) \{18sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc) \} 3 times, 10sc, ch1 and turn ( 82 sts)

Row 9: 11sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc) \{20sc, in ch3 make (sc, ch3, sc) \} 3 times, 11sc, ch1 and turn ( 90 sts )


## Joining sleeves:

Row 10: 12sc, in ch3 make a sc, ch4, in the next ch3 make a sc, 22sc, in the next ch3 make a sc, ch4, in the next ch3 make a sc, 12sc, ch1 and turn ( 50 sts )


Change to white
Row 11: sc in each st and ch, ch1 and turn (58 sts)
Change to black
Row 12-13: sc in each st across, ch1 and turn (58 sts)
Change to white
Row 14-15: sc in each st across, ch1 and turn (58 sts)


Change to black
Row 16-17: sc in each st across, ch1 and turn (58 sts)

Change to white
Row 18-20: sc in each st across, ch1 and turn (58 sts)


Change to black
Row 21-22: sc in each st across, ch1 and turn (58 sts)
Then edging the whole piece with a sc.


## Sleeves:

With black yarn
Rnd 1: Attach yarn to the ch3 space, and make a sc, then sc in the next 22 sts, sc in the ch3 space, sc in the next 4 chs , sl st to the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{st}$. (28 sts)

Rnd 2-4: sc in each st around, sl st to the $1^{\text {st }}$ st ( 28 sts)


## Vest:

With yellow saffron

## Part A:

Ch31, starting from $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook
Row 1: hdc in each st across, ch1 and turn (30 sts)
Row 2-8: working BLO, hdc in each st across, ch1 and turn (30 sts)


Note: continue working BLO till the end

Row 9: hdc dec, 26 hdc, hdc dec, ch1 and turn ( 28 sts)
Row 10: hdc dec, 24 hdc, hdc dec, ch1 and turn (26 sts)
Row 11: hdc dec, 22 hdc, hdc dec, ch1 and turn ( 24 sts)
Row 12: hdc dec, 20 hdc, hdc dec, ch1 and turn (22 sts)


Row 13-16: hdc in each st across, ch1 and turn (22 sts)
Fasten off!

## Part B: make 2

Ch 18
Row 1: hdc in each st across, ch1 and turn (17 sts)
Row 2-8: working BLO, hdc in each st across, ch1 and turn (17 sts)
Note: continue working BLO till the end
Row 9: hdc dec, 15 hdc, ch1 and turn (16 sts)
Row 10: 14 hdc, hdc dec, ch1 and turn (15 sts)
Row 11: hdc dec, 13 hdc, ch1 and turn (14 sts)
Row 12: 12 hdc , hdc dec, ch1 and turn (13 sts)

Row 13-16: hdc in each st across, ch1 and turn (13 sts)
Fasten off!


## Sewing parts together

1) Attach part $A$ to $B$ by sc, ch1 from row to 1 to 8
2) Attach part A, B2, by sc, ch1 from row 1 to 8
3) Sew 6 sts, of the shoulder part together from each side, leaving 10 sts of part A unworked.


## Hoodie

Working on the unused sts from part $B$ \& $A$, so you will have 7 sts from part $B+10$ sts from part $A+7$ sts from part $B+6$ corners sts (3sts at the joining pieces) $=7+10+7+6=30$ sts


Row 1-12: Working BLO, hdc in each st across, ch1 and turn (30 sts)


Fold it in half and sew it together with a sc.


Fasten off!


Final step: edging the whole piece with a sc.


Hat:
With brown
MC
Rnd 1: 10 dc into the MC (10 sts)
Rnd 2: (dc, FPDC in the same st) 10 times, sl st (20 sts)
Rnd 3: (dc, \{dc,FPDC in the same st\}) 10 times, sl st (30
sts) Rnd 4: (2dc,\{dc, FPDC in the same st\}) 10 times, sl
st (40 sts) Rnd 5: (3dc, \{dc, FPDC in the same st\})

10times, sl st (50 sts)

Rnd 6: (4dc, $\{d \mathrm{dc}$, FPDC in the same st $\}$ ) 10 times, sl st
(60 sts)


Rnd 7-8: (dc in each st, FPDC around each FPDC of the pervious rnd), sl st (60 sts)

Rnd 9: hdc in each st, sl st (60 sts)


Rnd 10-11: FPSC around the next 26 sts, 34sc, sl st ( 60 sts)
Fasten off

## Brim:

We will be working on only the 26 sts.
Row 1: (2 sc, sc inc) 8 times, $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1$ and turn ( 34 sts )


Row 2: working BLO, sc in each st, then hdc in the unworked st of the hat, then sl st to the next, ch1 and turn. (35 sts)

Note: after finishing each row you will do this (hdc in the unworked st of the hat which is st number $27^{\text {th }}$, then sl st to the next st which is st number $28^{\text {th }}$, then ch1 and turn.


Row 3-5: sc in each st across, then hdc in the unworked st of the hat,
then sl st to the next, ch1 and turn.
Row 6: (4sc, sc inc) repeat till the end of this row, then hdc in the unworked st of the hat, then sl st to the next, ch1 and turn. ( 46 sts )
Row 7: repeat row 3 but in each st around (the whole hat) ( 46 brim + 34 of the hat)

## Fasten off!

Embroider with Brown DMC thread it like the picture above.



## Bag:

With brown yarn
Ch9
Rnd 1: 7sc, 4sc in the last st, working on the opposite side, 6sc, 3sc in the last st. (20 sts)

Rnd 2: sc inc, 6sc, 4sc inc, 6sc, 3sc inc. (28 sts)
Rnd 3: sc, sc inc, 7sc, (sc inc, sc) 3 times, sc inc, 7sc, (sc inc, sc) 2 times, sc inc. (36 sts)

Rnd 4: 2 sc, sc inc, 8 sc, (sc inc, sc) 3 times, sc inc, 8 sc, (sc inc, 2sc) 2 times, sc inc. (44 sts)

Rnd 5: 3sc, sc inc, 9 sc, (sc inc, 3sc) 3 times, sc inc, 9 sc, (sc inc, 3sc) 2 times, sc inc. (52 sts)


Rnd 6: working BLO, sc in each st (52 sts)

Rnd 7-24: sc in each st around (52 sts)


Change to white
Rnd 25: working BLO, sc in each st, sl st (52 sts)


Rnd 26: ch1, working in BLO, dc in each st, sl st (52 sts) Fastne off!

## Straps:

Attach the yarn at BL of rnd 6 at the last inc, then make a foundation of $50 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sl}$ st to the BL of rnd 25 right at the middle of it, then make another foundation of 50 sc , sl st to the beg inc of rnd 6 .


## Bag pocket:

Ch7
Row 1: sc in each st across, ch1 and turn ( 6 sts)
Row 2-7: sc in each st, ch1 and turn ( 6 sts)
Row 8: edging the whole piece with a sc.
Row 9: working BLO, sc in each st, only on the 3 sides
Row 10-11: sc in each st across, ch1 and turn.


Sew it to the bag

## Bag base:

Repeat rnds 1-5 of the bag, sew it to the BL of the bag using brown DMC thread.




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
