

## 1. INSTRUMENTS AND MATERIALS

- 1.50 mm hook
- Gray yarn
- Sewing needle
- 2 Safety eyes 7 mm
- Stuffing material

This toy was crocheted with "YarnArt - BEGONIA" yarn. They are $100 \%$ cotton Mercerized, $169 \mathrm{~m} / 50 \mathrm{~g}$. To create a toy with a height of 7 cm you must crochet with single yarn using a 1.50 mm hook. The stuffing material used in this toy is polyester wadding.

*explanation:

1) make a loop around the finger; 2) with the help of the hook, pull the thread through the open loop; 3) Crochet 1 Sc in open loop the crochet as the instructions indicate and pull the wire to close the loop.

## Useful Tips:

1. Use a smaller hook size than suggested on yarn label. For example, if the yarn label suggests that I use an H/3.00mm hook, I would use a $\mathrm{H} / 1.50 \mathrm{~mm}$ hook instead.
2. The toy must be crocheted with tight stitches, to be sure that there won't be any holes through which stuffing material can be seen.
3. To keep track of the beginning of the row, use a marker. Pin marker to the last loop of the row. Every new row must be finished with a loop at the marker.

## 3. HEAD

## With Gray yarn

1 row: 6sc in magic circle (6)
2 row: (1sc, INC) repeat 3 times (9)
3 row: 3DEC , 3INC (9)
4 row: 2DEC, 1sc, 1INC, 1sc, 1INC, 1sc (9)
5 row: 1sc, 2DEC, 1sc, 2INC, 1sc (9)
6 row: sc in each sc around (9)
7 row: (2sc, INC) repeat 3 times (12)
8 row: INC, 4DEC, 3INC (12)
9 row: sc in each sc around (12)
10 row: (3sc, INC) repeat 3 times (15)
11 row: 2INC, 5DEC, 3INC (15)
12 row: sc in each sc around (15)
13 row: (4sc, INC) repeat 3 times (18)
14 row: 3INC, 6DEC, 3INC (18)
15 row: sc in each sc around (18)
16 row: 4INC, 12sc, 2INC (24)
17 row: (1sc, INC) repeat 4 times, $12 \mathrm{sc},(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{INC})$ repeat 2 times (30)
18 row: (2sc, INC) repeat 4 times, 12sc, (2sc, INC) repeat 2 times (36)
19 row: (3sc, INC) repeat 4 times, 12sc, (3sc, INC) repeat 2 times (42)
20 - 24 rows: sc in each sc around (42)

Give a pause but do not cut the yarn. Insert the first safety eye between rows 17 and 18. Count 6sc and insert the second eye.

25 row: (5sc, DEC) repeat 6 times (36)
26 row: (4sc, DEC) repeat 6 times (30)
27 row: (3sc, DEC) repeat 6 times (24)
Stuff detail with stuffing material.
28 row: (2sc, DEC) repeat 6 times (18)
29 row: (1sc, DEC) repeat 6 times (12)
30 row: 6DEC (6).
Fasten and cut the yarn, leave a yarn for sewing. Using a yarn needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull it tight to close.


## 4. EARS

## With Gray yarn

1 row: 6sc in magic circle (6)
2 row: 6INC (12)
3 row: (1sc, INC) repeat 6 times (18)
4 row: (2sc, INC) repeat 6 times (24)
5 row: (3sc, INC) repeat 6 times (30)
6 row: (4sc, INC) repeat 6 times (36)
7 row: (5sc, INC) repeat 6 times (42)


8 row: (6sc, INC) repeat 6 times (48)
9 row: bring the two sides together with 22sc.


Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.
Make 2 ears.

Fold the ear in half and sew with a sewing needle.


Sew the ear on the side of the head, using the end of gray yarn that we left before.

Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the head.
The second ear must be sewn symmetrically.


Add a few strands of gray yarn on top of the head.


## 5. PAWS AND BODY

## With Gray yarn

1 row: 7sc in magic circle (7)
2 row: 7INC (14)
3 row: BLOsc in each sc around (14)
4 row: sc in each sc around (14)
5 - 6 rows: sc in each sc around (14)
Cut the yarn.
Make 4 details. Do not fasten off after finishing the fourth detail.

Let's start crocheting the body.
7 row: Connect the fourth paw with first paw...

your first sc is done!

... 14 sc , connect the first with second paw, 14 sc , connect the second paw with the third paw, 14sc, connect the third with the fourth paw (56)


Fasten all ends of the yarns (leave only the yarn to continue crocheting the body) and hide inside the paws.

8-12 rows: sc in each sc around (56)
13 row: (5sc, DEC) repeat 8 times (48)
14 row: sc in each sc around (48)
15 row: (4sc, DEC) repeat 8 times (40)
Give a pause but do not cut the yarn.
Sew the bottom, with a gray yarn, closing the hole between the legs.


Continue to crochet the body...
16 row: (3sc, DEC) repeat 8 times (32)
17 row: (2sc, DEC) repeat 8 times (24)
18 row: (2sc, DEC) repeat 6 times (18)
Stuff detail with stuffing material ${ }^{*}$, continue crocheting...

19 row: (1sc, DEC) repeat 6 times (12)
20 row: 6DEC (6), sl.
Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the body.

Connect the head to the body.

Sew with the end of the gray yarn that we left before.
Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the body.


## 6. TAIL <br> With Gray yarn

In row 13 between the hind paws, insert the crochet hook and make 5ch.

Cut the yarn leaving a small tail.
