Spring Willow Afghan

Play with color and new stitches to create an overlay effect!



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

48 inches x 55 inches, excluding Fringe

MATERIALS

- Premier Yarns Deborah Norville Everyday Soft Worsted medium (worsted) weight acrylic yarn (4 oz/203 yds/113g per skein):
 - 5 skeins each #1005 baby blue, #1016 kiwi and #1001 snow white
- Size I/9/5.5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch markers

GAUGE

16 dc = 4 inches

Gauge is not important for this project.

PATTERN NOTES

Leaf panels are worked lengthwise and joined as you go from left to right. Leaves and stripes are created as work progresses.

Leave long ends when changing color and incorporate ends into Fringe.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

Chain-1 at beginning of row counts as first single crochet unless otherwise stated.

Chain-3 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Use loose tension when working foundation chain and slip stitches unless otherwise stated.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Left leaf stitch (Left leaf st): With RS facing, yo 4 times, rotate work and insert hook in indicated st from top down, yo, pull up lp, [yo, pull through 2 lps on hook] twice, place marker in last back ridge made, [yo, pull through 2 lps on hook] twice, yo 3 times, insert hook in marked lp, yo, pull up lp, [yo, pull through 2 lps on hook] 3 times, yo, pull through 3 lps on hook. Remove marker.

Right leaf stitch (Right leaf st): With RS facing, yo 4 times, insert hook in back lp of indicated st, yo, pull up lp, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 3 times, yo 3 times, insert hook in same marked st, yo, pull up lp, [yo, pull through 2 lps on hook] 3 times, yo, pull through 3 lps on hook, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook. Remove marker.

Top stitch (top st): Holding yarn at back of work and keeping tension loose, insert hook in indicated st, yo, pull lp through st and lp on hook.

AFGHAN

Row 1 (RS): With blue, ch 170, dc in 4th ch from hook and in each rem ch across, remove lp from hook and secure with marker, do not turn. (168 dc)

Row 2 (RS): Working across opposite side of foundation ch and holding yarn to WS, **join** (see Pattern Notes) kiwi in first ch, sl st in next st and in each rem ch across, turn. Fasten off kiwi.





Row 3 (WS): Return lp of blue to hook, remove marker, **ch 1** (see Pattern Notes), sc in each of next 6 dc, [ch 1, place marker in next dc, sk dc just marked, sc in each of next 5 dc] across, ending last rep with sc in each of last 4 sts, turn. (142 sc, 26 ch-1 sps)

Row 4 (RS): Ch 3 (see Pattern Notes), dc in next st and in each rem st and ch sp across, remove lp from hook and secure with marker, do not turn. (168 dc)

Row 5 (RS): Join kiwi in first st, ch 1, sc in each of next 6 dc, *ch 1, place marker in next dc, sk marked dc, sc in next dc, **Left leaf st** (see Special Stitches) in marked dc 3 rows below, sk next dc, sc in each of next 3 dc, rep from * across, ending last rep with sc in each of last 2 dc, turn. Fasten off kiwi. (110 sc, 26 ch-1 sps, 26 Left leaf sts)

Row 6 (WS): Return lp of blue to hook, remove marker; working in **front lps** (see Stitch Guide), **sl st** (see Pattern Notes) in first sc, ch 3, dc in next and each st across, turn. (168 dc)

Row 7 (RS): Ch 1, sc in next dc and in each rem dc across, remove lp from hook and secure with marker, do not turn. (168 sc)

Row 8 (RS): With RS facing and working in **back lps** (see Stitch Guide), join kiwi in first st, sl st in next sc, ***Right leaf st** (see Special Stitches) in marked dc 3 rows below, sk next sc, sl st in each of next 5 sc, rep from * across, ending last rep with sl st in each of last 9 sts, turn. Fasten off kiwi. (136 sl sts, 26 Right leaf sts)

Row 9 (WS): Return lp of blue to hook, remove marker; working in unworked lps of previous sc row, ch 3, sk first sc, dc in each of next 8 sc, *sk next leaf, dc in next unworked sc under leaf st, dc in each of next 5 sc, rep from * across, ending last rep with dc in sc under last leaf, dc in each of last 2 sts, turn. Fasten off blue.

Row 10 (RS): Working in front lps, join white in first st, ch 3, dc in next st and in each rem st across, remove lp from hook and secure with marker, do not turn.

Row 11 (RS): Working in sts on row 9 at base of dc of row 10, with kiwi, **top st** (see Special Stitches) in each st across, turn. Fasten off kiwi.

Rows 12 & 13: With white, rep rows 3 and 4.

Row 14: With blue, rep row 5.

Rows 15 & 16: With white, rep rows 6 and 7.

Row 17: With blue, rep row 8.

Row 18: With white, rep row 9.

Row 19: With kiwi, rep row 10.

Row 20: With blue, rep row 11.

Rows 21 & 22: With kiwi, rep rows 3 and 4.

Row 23: With white, rep row 5.

Rows 24 & 25: With kiwi, rep rows 6 and 7.

Row 26: With white, rep row 8.

Row 27: With kiwi, rep row 9.

Row 28: With blue, rep row 10.

Row 29: With white, rep row 11.

Rows 30–110: [Rep rows 3–29 consecutively] 3 times.

Rows 111–135: Rep rows 3–27 consecutively.

Row 136 (RS): With RS facing, join white in first st, sl st firmly in each rem dc across. Fasten off.

FRINGE

Using photo as a guide, add Fringe in each row end at center of each leaf stripe and top st stripe on each end of Afghan, matching Fringe color to leaf and top st color, as follows: Cut 5 strands of matching yarn, each 16 inches in length. Holding all 5 strands tog, fold in half, pull fold through row end, pull ends of strand and matching yarn tail through fold, pull to tighten. Trim to desired length.

Weave in rem yarn ends.





Half double crochet decrease (hdc dec): (Yo, insert hook, yo,


(Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.

insert hook, yo, draw lp through, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.




Front loop (front lp) Back loop (back lp)


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Front Loop Back Loop

Front post stitch (fp): Back post stitch (bp): When working post st, insert hook from right to left around post of st on previous row.




Half double crochet (hdc): Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook.



Double treble crochet (dtr): Yo 3 times, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 4 times.



Treble crochet decrease (tr dec): Holding back last Ip of each st, tr in each of the sts indicated, yo, pull through all Ips on hook.




Slip stitch (sl st): Insert hook in st, pull through both lps on hook.



Chain color change (ch color change)

Yo with new color, draw through last lp on hook.




Double crochet color change (dc color change)

Drop first color, yo with new color, draw through last 2 lps of st.



Treble crochet (tr):

Yo twice, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 3 times.





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
