Skill Level  INTERMEDIATE

Finished Sizes

Instructions given fit 32–34-inch bust (small); changes for 36–38-inch bust (medium), 40–42-inch bust (large) and 44–46-inch bust (X-large) are in [].

Finished Garment Measurements

Bust: 36 1/2 inches (small), 39 1/2 inches (medium), 45 inches (large), 50 1/2 inches (X-large)

Materials

- Patons Grace light (light worsted) weight yarn (1 3/4 oz/136 yds/50g per ball): 13 [14, 16, 17] balls #60130 sky
- Size F/5/3.75mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

Gauge

23 sts = 4 inches; 22 rows = 4 inches
Take time to check gauge.

Special Stitch

Pattern row: Ch 1, sc in both lps of first st, sc in back lps of next st, [sc in front lps of next st, sc in back lps of next st] across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

TOP

Front/back

Row 1 (RS): Ch 106 [114, 130, 146], sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn. (105 [113, 129, 145] sc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, *sc in back lp of next st**, sc in front lp of next st, rep from * across, ending last rep at **, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

Rows 3–22 [3–26, 3–30, 3–34]: Ch 1, sc in both lps of first st, *sc in back lp of next st**, sc in front lp of next st, rep from * across, ending last rep at **, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

Armhole Shaping

Row 23 [27, 31, 35]: Sl st in each of first 6 [6, 8, 10] sts, sc in both lps of next st, work in pattern across to last 7 [7, 9, 11] sts, sc in both lps of



next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (93 [101, 113, 125] sc)

Row 24 [28, 32, 36]: Ch 1, work in pattern (see Special Stitch) across, turn.

Row 25 [29, 33, 37]: Sl st in each of first 2 [2, 3, 3] sts, work in pattern across, leaving last 2 [2, 3, 3] sts unworked, turn. (89 [97, 107, 119] sc)

Rows 26–28 [30–32, 34–36, 38–40]:

Rep last 2 rows alternately. (85 [93, 101, 113] sc)

Row 29 [33, 37, 41]: Ch 1, work in pattern across, turn.

Row 30 [34, 38, 42]: Ch 1, sl st in first st, work in pattern leaving last st unworked, turn. (83 [91, 99, 111] sc)

Row 31 [35, 39, 43]: Ch 1, work in pattern across, turn.

Next rows: Rep last 2 rows, 2 [4, 3, 6]

times, ending with (79 [83, 93, 99] sc) in last row.

Next rows: Work even in pattern until piece measures 7 1/2 [8, 8 1/2, 9] inches from beg of Armhole Shaping, ending with WS row.

Last row: Work in established pattern across first 10 [10, 15, 15] sts (shoulder), sl st in each of next 59 [63, 63, 69] sts, work in established pattern across (shoulder). Fasten off.

Lace

Row 1: With RS facing, working in starting ch on opposite side of row 1 on Front/Back, join with sl st in first ch, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each ch across, turn. (105 [113, 129, 145] dc)

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, [ch 1, sk next 3 sts, (dc, ch 1) 4 times in next st, sk next 3 sts, sc in next st] across, turn. (13 [14, 16, 18] scallops)

Row 3: Ch 6 (counts as dc and ch-3 sp), sk next sc and next 2 dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, *ch 3, dc in next sc**, ch 3, sk next 2 dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, rep from * across, ending last rep at **, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, *3 dc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next sc, 3 dc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, rep from * across, turn. (105 [113, 129, 145] dc)

Next rows: Rep rows 2–4 consecutively 6 [6, 8, 8] times, then rep row 2. Fasten off.

Sleeve

Row 1: Ch 66 [74, 82, 90], sc in 2nd ch

from hook and in each ch across, turn. (65 [73, 81, 89] sc)

Rows 2–4: Work even in pattern.

Row 5: Ch 1, sk first st, sc in next st, work in pattern leaving last st unworked, turn. (63 [71, 79, 87] sc)

Row 6: Work even in pattern.

Next rows: [Rep rows 5 and 6] 2 [3, 3, 2] times, ending with (59 [65, 73, 83] sc) in last row.

Next rows: Work next 3 rows even in pattern.

Inc row: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, work in pattern across with 2 sc in last st, turn. (61 [67, 75, 85] sc)

Next rows: Continue in established pattern work inc row every other row, ending with (63 [71, 81, 91] sc) in last row.

Next rows: Continue in established pattern, working inc row every 6th row, ending with (81 [83, 93, 103] sc) in last row.

Next rows: Work even in pattern until you have 76 [78, 82, 86] rows completed.

Cap Shaping

Row 77 [79, 83, 87]: Sl st in each of first 6 [6, 8, 10] sts, ch 1, sc in both lps of next st, work in pattern across to last 7 [7, 9, 11] sts, sc in both lps of next st, leaving rem sts unworked, turn. (69 [71, 77, 83] sc)

Row 78 [80, 84, 88]: Work even in pattern.

Rows 79 [81, 85, 89]: Sl st in each of first 2 [2, 3, 3] sts, ch 1, work in pattern across leaving last 2 [2, 3,

3] sts unworked, turn. (65 [67, 71, 77] sc)

Row 80 [82, 86, 90]: Work even in pattern.

Next rows: Rep last 2 rows, ending with (61 [63, 65, 71] sc) in last row.

Next rows: Continue in established pattern, dec 1 st at each end of every row 5 times, ending with (51 [53, 55, 61] sc) in last row.

Next rows: Continue in pattern, dec 1 st at each end of every other row 4 [5, 6, 7] times, ending with (43, 43, 43, 47] sc) in last row.

Next row: Sl st in each of first 3 sts, work in established pattern across, leaving last 3 sts unworked, turn. (37 [37, 37, 41] sc)

Next row: Sl st in first st, ch 1, work in pattern across, leaving last st unworked, turn. (35 [35, 35, 39] sc)

Next rows: Rep last 2 rows twice, ending with (19 [19, 19, 23] sc) in last row. Fasten off.

Lace

Rows 1–4: Rep rows 1–4 of Lace Front/Back.

Next rows: Rep rows 2–4 of Lace Front/Back consecutively twice, then rep row 2 again. At end of last row, fasten off.

Finishing

Sew shoulder seams.

Sew in Sleeves, sew Sleeve and side seams.
