



The Primrose Motif



HOW TO CROCHET PRIMROSE MOTIF



Description

The Primrose Motif is a simple flower pattern that works up very quickly. It's a great way to practice color work for beginners. You can use this as an embellishment on hats, gloves, scarves, or blankets.

Stitch Details

Skill Level

Easy

Row Count

Number of Rows: 3

Pattern Repeat

Ch 4, join with a Sl st to form a ring

Abbreviations

ch - Chain Stitch

dc - Double Crochet

sc - Single Crochet

tr - Triple Crochet

hdc - Half Double Crochet

Pattern Instructions

Foundation Chain: **With A**, ch 4, join with a Sl st to form a ring

Round 1: **With A**, ch 4 (counts as a dc, ch 1), *1 dc in ring, ch 1; rep from * 6 times, join with a Sl st in 3rd ch of the beg ch-4, end off A.

Round 2: **Join B** in any ch-1 space, ch 2 (counts as first hdc), [1 dc, 1 tr, 1 dc, 1 hdc] in same space, [1 hdc, 1 dc, 1 tr, 1 dc, 1hdc] in each ch-1 space around, join with a Sl st to beg ch-2 (8-petals).

Round 3: Ch 1, *[2 sc in next st] 4 times, Sl st next st; rep from * 7 times more, join with a Sl st in first sc, end off.
