Skill Level

Finished Size

Instructions given fit size small; changes for medium, large, X-large, 2X-large, 3X-large and 4X-large are in [].

Finished Measurements

Bust: 42 inches (*small*) [46 inches (*medium*); 50 inches (*large*); 54 inches (*X-large*); 58 inches (*2X-large*); 62 inches (*3X-large*); 66 inches (*4X-large*)]

Length: 26 inches (*small*) [26½ inches (*medium*); 27 inches (*large*); 27½ inches (*X-large*); 28 inches (*2X-large*); 28½ inches (*3X-large*); 29 inches (*4X-large*)]

Materials

- Lion Brand 24/7 Cotton medium (worsted) weight mercerized cotton yarn (3½ oz/186 yds/100g per ball):
7 [8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 12] balls #178 jade
- Size H/8/5mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch markers



Gauge

14 dc = 4 inches; 8 dc rows = 4 inches

3 reps in Lace pattern = 4 inches

Take time to check gauge.

Pattern Notes

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.

Chain-3 at beginning of round or row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

Last stitch of each row is worked into top of beginning chain-3 unless otherwise stated.

Pattern Stitch

Lace pattern

Row 1 (WS): Ch 2, sk 3 sts, [in next dc work (dc, ch 1, dc), ch 2, sk 5 sts] 2 times, in next st work (dc, ch 1, dc), ch 2, sk 3 sts.

Row 2: [Ch 2, sc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, in next ch-1 sp work (dc, ch 1, dc)] 3 times (*each rep counts as 1 motif*), ch 2, sc in last ch-2 sp, ch 2.

Row 3: Ch 2, [in next ch-1 sp work (dc, ch 1, dc), ch 2] 3 times.

Rep [Rows 2 and 3] for pattern as indicated.

Tee

Back

Row 1 (RS): Loosely ch 77 [85, 91, 99, 105, 113, 119], dc in back bump of 4th ch from hook, dc in back bump of each ch across, turn. (75 [83, 89, 97, 103, 111, 117] dc)

Rows 2–3: Ch 3 (*see Pattern Notes*), dc in each dc across, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in next dc, **Lace pattern** (*see Pattern Stitch*) across next 19 sts, dc in each of next 33 [41, 47, 55, 61, 69, 75] dc, to last 21 dc, Lace pattern on next 19 sts, dc in next dc and in **last st** (*see Pattern Notes*), turn.

Work in established pattern until piece measures 17 [17½, 17, 17½, 17, 17½, 18] inches.

Place a marker each side to mark beg of armhole.

Continue in established pattern until piece measures 26 [26½, 27, 27½, 28, 28½, 29] inches, (10 [10, 11, 11, 12, 12, 12] inches from marker), ending with a WS row.

Fasten off.

Front

Work as Back until piece measures 18 [18½, 19, 19, 19½, 19½, 20] inches, ending with a WS row.

Left Shoulder

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3, dc in next dc, Lace pattern over next 19 sts, dc in each of next 16 [20, 23, 27, 30, 34, 37] dc, turn, leaving rem sts unworked.

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in each of next 15 [19, 22, 26, 29, 33, 36] dc, Lace pattern over next 19 sts, dc in last 2 sts, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in next dc, Lace pattern over next 19 sts, dc in each st across, turn.

Rep [Rows 2 and 3] until piece measures 26 [26½, 27, 27½, 28, 28½, 29] inches, ending with a WS row.

Fasten off.

Right Shoulder

Sk 1 dc mid Front at neck opening after Left Shoulder piece, **join** (*see Pattern Notes*) in next dc.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3, dc in each of next 15 [19, 22, 26, 29, 33, 36] dc, Lace pattern over next 19 sts, dc in last 2 sts, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in next dc, Lace pattern over next 19 sts, dc in each st across, turn.

Rep [Rows 1 and 2] until piece measures the same as left side, ending with a WS row.

Fasten off.

Assembly

Place a marker each side of the center 25 [25, 27, 27, 29, 29, 31] dc along the upper edge on Back to mark neck opening. Place a marker after the first 12 [12, 13, 13, 14, 14, 15] dc from neck opening on each front piece.

Sew shoulder seams from shoulder edge to markers.

Sleeves

Work between the markers marking the armhole.

Row 1 (RS): Join in the first st after the marker, ch 1, work 76 [76, 81, 81, 91, 91, 91] sc evenly along the armhole edge to next marker, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in next sc, ch 2, sk next 3 sts, [in next dc work (dc, ch 1, dc), ch 2, sk 4 sts] across to last 6 sts, in next st work (dc, ch 1, dc), ch 2, sk 3 sc, dc in each of last 2 sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 2, sc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, in next ch-1 sp work (dc, ch 1, dc)] across to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in last ch-2 sp, ch 2, dc in last 2 sts, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 2, [in next ch-1 sp work (dc, ch 1, dc), ch 2] across to last 2 sts, dc in last 2 sts, turn.

Rep [Rows 3 and 4] until sleeve measures 4½ [5, 5½, 6, 6½, 7, 7½] inches, ending with a RS row.

Fasten off.

Hood

Starting at the upper corner of neck opening on Left Front, with WS facing, join yarn in first st.

Row 1 (WS): Ch 3, work 1 dc in each of next 11 [11, 12, 12, 13, 13, 14] dc along neck line, 1 dc in shoulder seam, 1 dc in each of the 25 [25, 27, 27, 29, 29, 31] dc along neck at Back, 1 dc in next shoulder seam, 1 dc in each of next 12 [12, 13, 13, 14, 14, 15] dc along other neck edge, turn. (51 [51, 55, 55, 59, 59, 63] dc)

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in each of next 4 [4, 2, 4, 2, 2, 2] sts, [2 dc in next st, dc in next 1 {1, 2, 1, 2, 2, 3} st(s)] 20 [20, 16, 22, 18, 18, 14] times, dc in each rem st across, turn. (71 [71, 71, 77, 77, 77, 77] dc)

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk 3, [in next dc work (dc, ch 1, dc), ch 2, sk 4 sts] across to last 6 sts, in next st work (dc, ch 1, dc), ch 2, sk 3 dc, dc in last 2 sts, turn. (13 [13, 13, 14, 14, 14, 14] motif reps, 2 dc at each end)

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 2, sc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, in next ch-1 sp work (dc, ch 1, dc)] across to last ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in last ch-2 sp, ch 2, dc in last 2 sts, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 2, [in next ch-1 sp work (dc, ch 1, dc), ch 2] across to last 2 sts, dc in last 2 sts, turn.

Rep [Rows 4 and 5] until hood measures 11 [11, 11½, 11½, 11½, 12, 12] inches, ending with a WS row.

Fasten off.

Finishing

Fold hood double and sew tog at top.

Sew sleeve seam. Sew side seams starting at armhole and sew tog until 6 [6½, 7, 7½, 8, 8½, 9] inches rem, leaving a split at the bottom on each side.

Weave in ends.

Neck Opening Edging

Starting at the top of hood, join yarn at the seam.

Ch 3, work dc evenly along edge down along the side of Hood opening, along the side of neck opening, at bottom of split work **dc dc** (see *StitchGuide.com*) in next 3 sts, continue with dc up evenly along the other side of neck and Hood, join in beg of rnd.

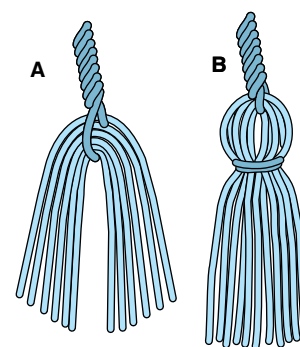
Fasten off.

Twisted Cords

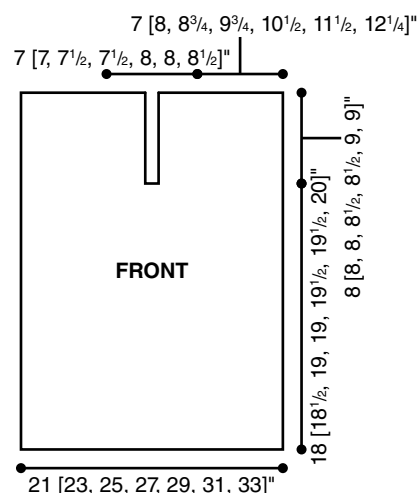
Cut 2 70-inch strands. Tie a knot in one end and secure end to a stationary object. Twist yarn until it begins to double back on itself. Fold in half with all ends tog and allow to twist up on itself. Tie a knot each end. Pull the cord through the edge sts in the neck opening like when threading a shoelace in a shoe.

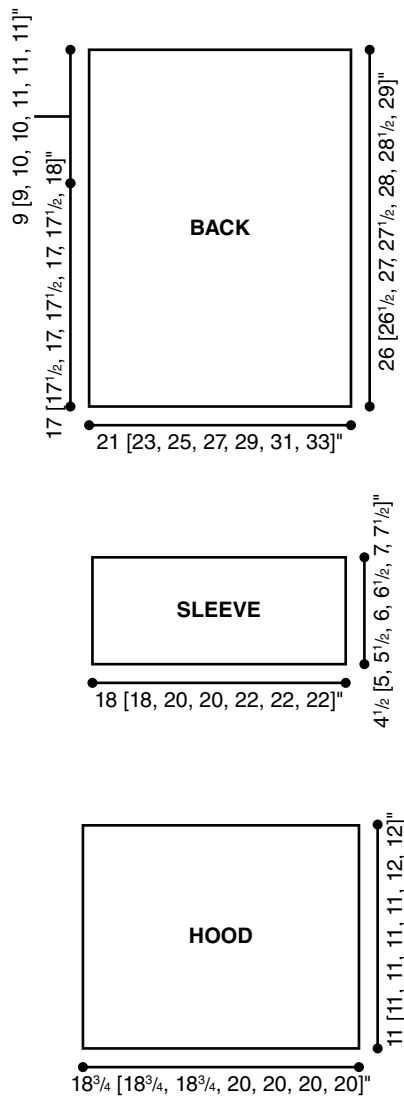
Tassels

Cut 20 8-inch long strands. Separate the cord above the knot and pull 10 strands halfway through. Fold strands around the knot, and twist a strand of yarn around the strands ½ inch below the fold. Tie a firm knot. Rep in the other end. Trim tassels even. ●
