SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZE

Finished Circumference About 27 in. (68.5 cm)

Finished Height About 5 1/2 in. (14 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Martha Stewart Crafts® Mambo (Art. #5600)
 - 574 Crocodile 5 balls (A)
 - 553 Zebra 3 balls (B)
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size Q-19 (15 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Needle felting tool and mat

NOTES

1. Basket is worked in one piece in continuous rounds. Do not turn or join unless instructed to do so.
2. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete the stitch. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.
3. Before beginning, make yarn into bigger balls – one of each color. To do this, unwind 2 balls of A. With needle felting tool and mat, needle felt one end of each unwound yarn to join into one length. Repeat until all A is wound into one ball. Repeat to make one ball of B.

BASKET

With A, ch 4, join with a slip st to make a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 8 sc in ring. Place a marker for beginning of rnd, move marker up as you complete each rnd.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around – you will have 16 sc.

Rnd 3: *Sc in next sc, work 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around – 24 sc.

Rnds 4-6: Sc in each sc around, changing to B in last sc of Rnd 6.

Fasten off A.

Rnds 7-8: With B, sc in each sc around. At the end of Rnd 8, join with slip st in beg sc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

With needle felting tool and mat, needle felt yarn ends on the inside of Basket.

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ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

rnd(s) = round(s)

sc = single crochet

st(s) = stitch(es)
