This light shawlette has a vintage country look in a shape reminiscent of spokes on a wheel. It lies gracefully across the shoulders and ends with a gently ruffled border.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

27 inches wide x 15½ inches long from center to bottom

## MATERIALS

- Plymouth Yarn Cleo light (DK) weight cotton yarn (1¾ oz/125 yds/50g per skein):  
4 skeins #0167 bok choy
- Size G/6/4mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle



## GAUGE

16 dc = 4 inches; 8 rows = 4 inches

Take time to check gauge.

## PATTERN NOTES

Refer to Stitch Diagram as needed.

Chain-3 at beginning of row counts as first double crochet unless otherwise stated.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

**Beginning shell (beg shell):** Ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) as indicated in instructions.

**Shell:** (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) as indicated in instructions.

**Beginning large shell (beg lg shell):** Ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) as indicated in instructions.

**Large shell (lg shell):** (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) as indicated in instructions.

## SHAWL

### Body

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 10, dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in each of next 5 chs, 9 dc in last ch, working on opposite side of foundation ch, dc in each of next 5 chs, 2 dc in last ch, turn. (23 dc)

**Row 2 (WS): Ch 3** (see *Pattern Notes*), dc in same st, [ch 1, sk next dc, 2 dc in next dc] 3 times, [ch 1, sk next dc, 3 dc in next dc] 4 times, [ch 1, sk next dc, 2 dc in next dc] 3 times, ch 1, sk next dc, 2 dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (28 dc, 11 ch-1 sps)

**Row 3:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, [ch 1, 2 dc in each of next 3 dc] 4 times, [ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 1, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (40 dc, 11 ch-1 sps)

**Row 4:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, \*ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc, rep from \* across to last 2 sts, ch 1, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (40 dc, 19 ch-1 sps)

**Row 5:** Ch 3, dc in same st, ch 1, 2 dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, [ch 3, sc in sp between next 2 dc, ch 3, sk next ch, dc in each of next 2 dc, ch 2, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 3, sc in sp between next 2 dc, ch 3, sk next ch, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 1, 2 dc in

next dc, ch 1, 2 dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (36 dc, 10 ch-1 sps, 6 ch-3 sps, 4 sc, 3 ch-2 sps)

**Row 6:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, ch 2, [2 dc in each of next 2 dc, ch 4, sk next (ch 3, sc, ch 3), 2 dc in each of next 2 dc, ch 2] 4 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 1, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (52 dc, 8 ch-1 sps, 5 ch-2 sps, 4 ch-4 sps)

**Row 7:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, ch 2, [dc in each of next 4 dc, ch 3, sc around center of next ch-4 sp, ch 3, dc in each of next 4 dc, ch 2] 4 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 1, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (52 dc, 8 ch-1 sps, 5 ch-2 sps, 4 sc, 8 ch-3 sps)

**Row 8:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, ch 3, [2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 5, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 3] 4 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 1, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (68 dc, 8 ch-1 sps, 5 ch-3 sps, 4 ch-5 sps)

**Row 9:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, ch 3, [dc in each of next 6 dc, ch 3, sc around center of next ch-5 sp, ch 3, dc in each of next 6 dc, ch 3] 4 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 1, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (68 dc, 8 ch-1 sps, 13 ch-3 sps, 4 sc)







**Row 10:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, ch 3, [dc in each of next 6 dc, ch 6, dc in each of next 6 dc, ch 3] 4 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 1, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 1, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (68 dc, 8 ch-1 sps, 5 ch-3 sps, 4 ch-6 sps)

**Row 11:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 2, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, ch 4, [2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 4 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 3, sc around center of next ch-6 sp, ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 4 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 4] 4 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 2, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 2, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (84 dc, 8 ch-2 sps, 5 ch-4 sps, 8 ch-3 sps, 4 sc)

**Row 12:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 2, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, ch 4, [dc in each of next 8 dc, ch 7, dc in each of next 8 dc, ch 4] 4 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 2, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 2, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (84 dc, 8 ch-2 sps, 5 ch-4 sps, 4 ch-7 sps)

**Row 13:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 2, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, ch 5, [dc in each of next 8 dc, ch 3, sc around center of next ch-7 sp, ch 3, dc in each of next 8 dc, ch 5] 4 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 2, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 2, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (84 dc, 8 ch-2 sps, 5 ch-5 sps, 8 ch-3 sps, 4 sc)

**Row 14:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 2, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, ch 5, [2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 6 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 8, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 6 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 5] 4 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 2, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 2, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (100 dc, 8 ch-2 sps, 5 ch-5 sps, 4 ch-8 sps)

**Row 15:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 3, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, ch 6, [dc in each of next 10 dc, ch 3, sc around center of next ch-8 sp, ch 3, dc in each of next 10 dc, ch 6] 4 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 3, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 3, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (100 dc, 16 ch-3 sps, 5 ch-6 sps)

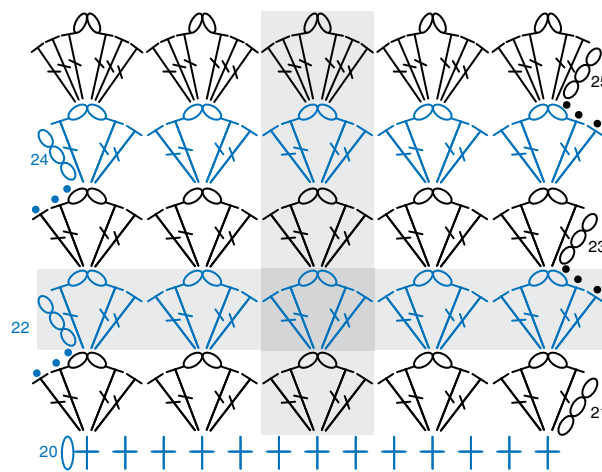
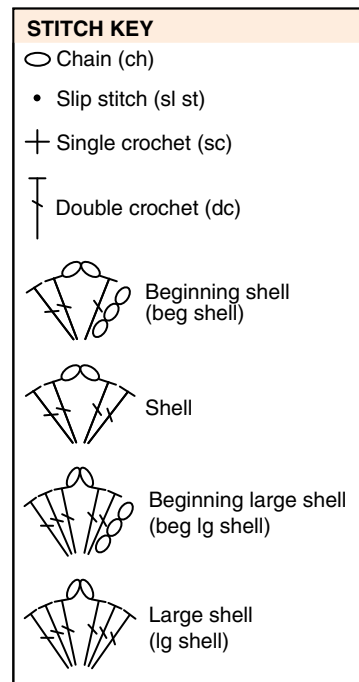
**Row 16:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 3, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, ch 6, [dc in each of next 10 dc, ch 9, dc in each of next 10 dc, ch 6] 4 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 3, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 3, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (100 dc, 8 ch-3 sps, 5 ch-6 sps, 4 ch-9 sps)

**Row 17:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 3, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, ch 6, [2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 8 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 3, sc around center of next ch-9 sp, ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each of next 8 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 6] 4 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 3, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 3, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (116 dc, 16 ch-3 sps, 5 ch-6 sps, 4 sc)

**Row 18:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 3, dc in each

of next 2 dc] 4 times, ch 6, [dc in each of next 12 dc, ch 10, dc in each of next 12 dc, ch 6] 4 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 3, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 3, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (116 dc, 8 ch-3 sps, 5 ch-6 sps, 4 ch-10 sps)

**Row 19:** Ch 3, dc in next dc, [ch 3, dc in each of next 2 dc] 4 times, ch 6, [dc in each of next 12 dc, ch 3, sc around center of next ch-10 sp,

ch 3, dc in each of next 12 dc, ch 6] 4 times, dc in each of next 2 dc, [ch 3, dc in each of next 2 dc] 3 times, ch 3, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn. (116 dc, 16 ch-3 sps, 5 ch-6 sps, 4 sc)

**Row 20 (WS):** Ch 1, work sc in each dc, 2 sc in each ch-3 sp, 6 sc in each ch-6 sp and sc in each sc across, turn. (182 sc)

**Border**

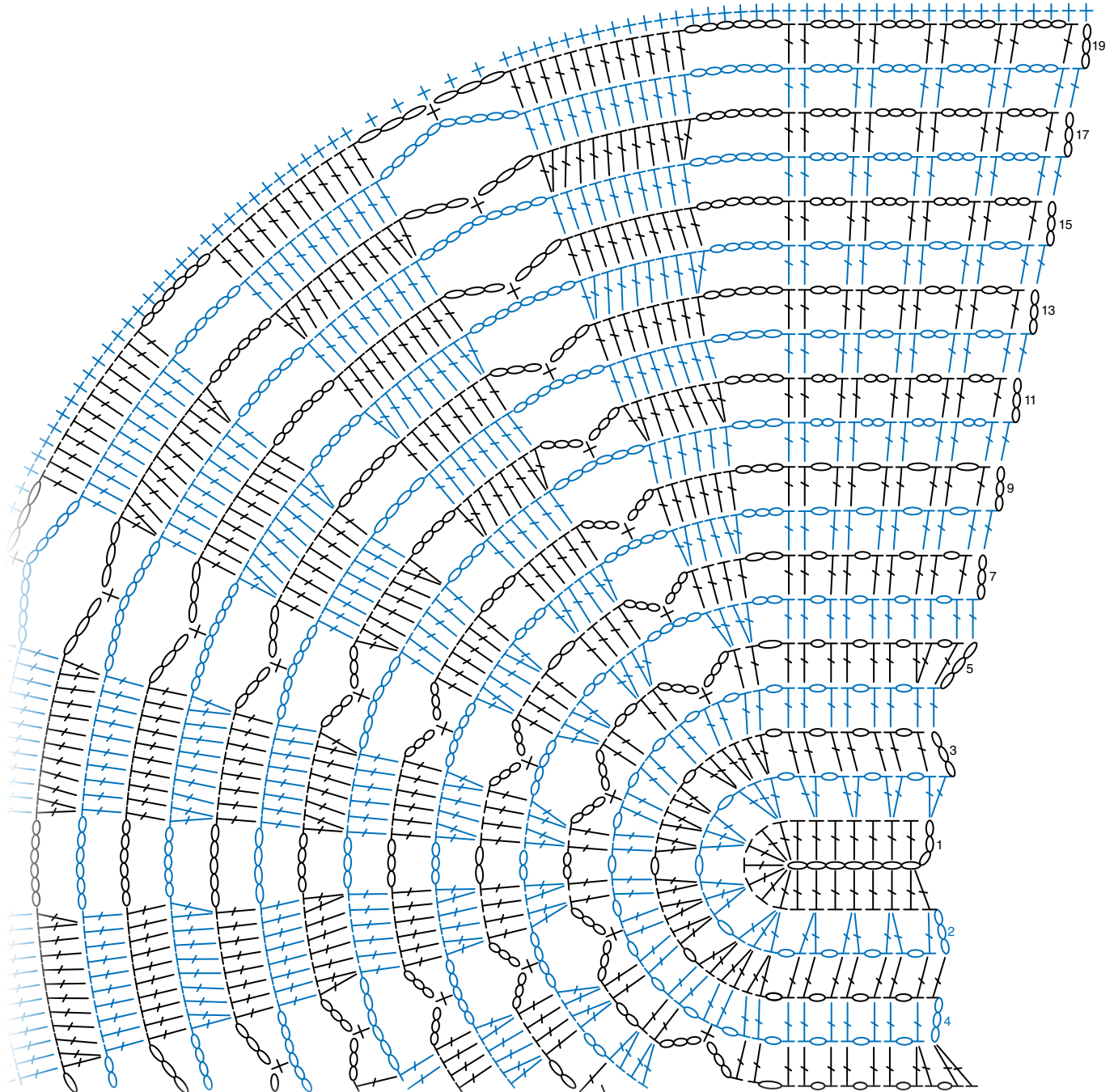
**Row 21 (RS):** Beg shell (see *Special Stitches*) in first sc, sk next 2 sc, **shell** (see *Special Stitches*) in next sc, \*sk next 2 sc, shell in next sc, rep from \* across, turn. (61 shells)

**Rows 22–24:** Sl st in each st to next ch-2 sp, beg shell in same sp, shell in each rem ch-2 sp across, turn.

**Row 25:** Sl st each st to next ch-2 sp, **beg lg shell** (see *Special Stitches*) in same sp, **lg shell** (see *Special Stitches*) in each ch-2 sp across. Fasten off. (61 lg shells)

**Finishing**

Block lightly, as desired. **C!**

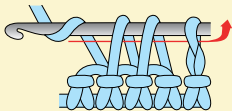

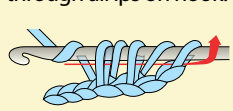

**Single crochet decrease (sc dec):**  
(Insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



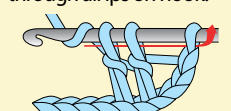
Example of 2-sc dec

**Half double crochet decrease (hdc dec):**  
(Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



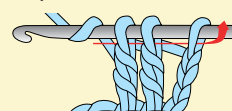
Example of 2-hdc dec

**Double crochet decrease (dc dec):** (Yo, insert hook, yo, draw lp through, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) in each of the sts indicated, yo, draw through all lps on hook.



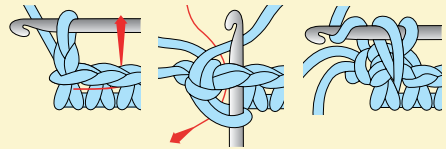
Example of 2-dc dec

**Treble crochet decrease (tr dec):** Holding back last lp of each st, tr in each of the sts indicated, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

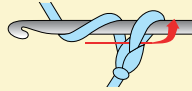


Example of 2-tr dec

**Reverse single crochet (reverse sc):** Ch 1, sk first st, working from left to right, insert hook in next st from front to back, draw up lp on hook, yo and draw through both lps on hook.

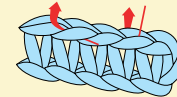


**Chain (ch):** Yo, pull through lp on hook.

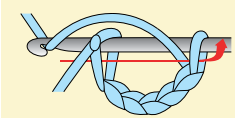


**Front loop (front lp)**  
**Back loop (back lp)**

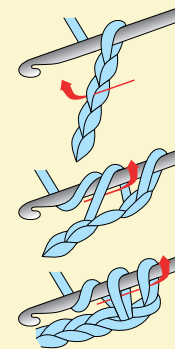
Front Loop Back Loop



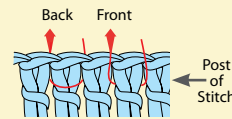
**Slip stitch (sl st):** Insert hook in st, pull through both lps on hook.



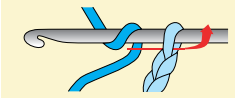
**Single crochet (sc):** Insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through both lps on hook.



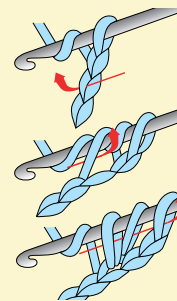
**Front post stitch (fp):**  
**Back post stitch (bp):** When working post st, insert hook from right to left around post of st on previous row.



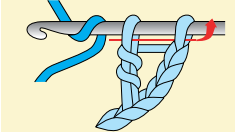
**Chain color change (ch color change)**  
Yo with new color, draw through last lp on hook.



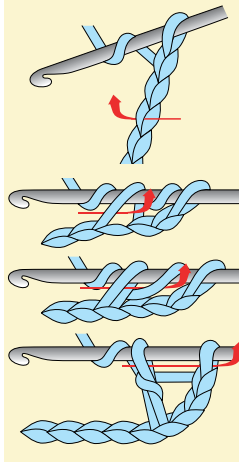
**Half double crochet (hdc):** Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hook.



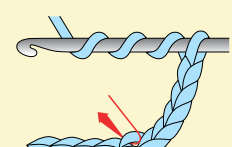
**Double crochet color change (dc color change)**  
Drop first color, yo with new color, draw through last 2 lps of st.



**Double crochet (dc):** Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] twice.



**Double treble crochet (dtr):** Yo 3 times, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 4 times.



**Treble crochet (tr):** Yo twice, insert hook in st, yo, pull through st, [yo, pull through 2 lps] 3 times.
