What you will need:
Red Heart ${ }^{\bullet}$ Boutique Midnight ${ }^{\oplus}$ : 3 balls 1945 Shadow

Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook:
6.5 mm [US K-10.5]

Yarn/tapestry needle
Gauge: Before blocking, 15 stitches $=4 "$ [ 10 cm ]; 15 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$ [10 $\mathrm{cm}]$. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain your gauge.

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Buy Yarn
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Red Heart ${ }^{\oplus}$ Boutique Midnigh ${ }^{\oplus}$, Art. E786 ( 70 g ), 153 yd ( 140 m ) balls


## Shaded Triangles Magic Scarf

> These crochet triangles show off the shading of the yarn to your advantage. No one will know how easy it was to create the beautiful shaded effect.

Scarf Measures $61 / 2 " \times 70 "[16.5 \mathrm{~cm} \times 178 \mathrm{~cm}]$, after blocking

Note: Scarf is worked in decreasing rows off of foundation. Each triangle after foundation is worked off the back spine of the previous triangle.

Tip: The decreasing edge on the first triangle is the same side as the beginning tail.

## SCARF

Ch 33.
Row 1 (foundation): Working in back bumps, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across-32 sc.
Row 2 (Bottom Edging): Ch 3, turn piece 90 degrees, slip st in end of Row 1, turn piece to work along chain side (bottom) of Row 1, ch 1 , [skip 1 st, (sc, hdc, sc) next st, skip 1 st, slip st in next st] 8 times, ch 3 , slip st in end of Row 1 . Row 3: Ch 2, working across Row 1, *skip 1 st, sc in next st, ch $1^{*}$, repeat from * to * 14 times, skip 1 st, sc in last st of row, turn-16 sc, 15 ch-1 spaces, 1 ch-2 space.
Row 4: Ch 2, *skip 1 st, sc in next ch-1 space, ch $1^{*}$, repeat from * to * across to last sc and ch-2 space, sc in last ch-2 space, turn-16 sc, 15 ch- 1 spaces, 1 ch-2 space. Row 5: Ch 2, *skip 1 st, sc in next ch-1 space, ch $1^{*}$, repeat from * to * across to last ch-1 space, sc in last ch-1 space, turn-15 sc, 14 ch-1 spaces, 1 ch-2 space.
Rows 6-33: [Repeat Rows 4 and 5] 14
times-1 sc, 1 ch-2 space at end of last row. Row 34: Ch 2, sc in ch-2 space.
Row 35: Ch 1, turn to work along the short edge of triangle, sc in end of next 32 rows, turn-32 sc.
Row 36: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn32 sc .
[Repeat Rows 3-36] 6 times.
[Repeat Rows 3-35] once.

## EDGING

Ch 1, [skip 1 st, (sc, hdc, sc) next st, skip 1 st, slip st in next st] 8 times.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Wet block gently.

ch = chain; hdc = half double crochet; mm $=$ millimeters; $\mathbf{s C}=$ single crochet; st(s) = stitch(es); yo = yarn over hook; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ${ }^{* *}=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
