SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: One Size

Beret Finished circumference About 20 in. (51 cm) Scarf About 6 x 54 in. (15 x 137 cm), at widest point.

- 792-411 Lion Brand Homespun Thick and Quick Yarn: Mixed Berries

 Ball
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials Crochet hook size L-11 (8 mm)

*<u>Homespun® Thick & Quick®</u> (Article #792). 88% Acrylic, 12% Polyester; package size: 8.00oz/227.00 gr. (160yds/146m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

6 sts + 4 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

FPSC (front post single crochet) Insert hook from front to back then to front, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook. Skip st behind the FPSC.

NOTES:

- 1. Beret is worked in joined rnds from top of Beret.
- 2. Scarf is worked back and forth in rows.

BERET

Note: Do not turn at ends of rnds. Ch 3.

Rnd 1: Work 10 sc in 3rd ch from hook; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), *dc in next st, ch 1; rep from * around; join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch - 10 dc and 10 ch-1 sps at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: SI st in first ch-1 sp, ch 2 (counts as first hdc in this rnd and in all following rnds), hdc in same ch-1 sp, ch 1, *2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from around; join with sI st in top of beg ch - 20 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 4: SI st in next hdc, ch 2, 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, *sk next hdc, hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * around; join with sI st in top of beg ch - 30 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 5: SI st in next hdc, ch 2, hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, *sk next hdc, hdc in next 2 hdc, 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * around; join with sI st in top of beg ch - 40 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 6: SI st in next hdc, ch 2, hdc in next 2 hdc, 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, *sk next hdc, hdc in next 3 hdc, 2 hdc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * around; join with sI st in top of beg ch - 50 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 7: Ch 2, hdc in next 4 hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, *hdc in next 5 hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from * around; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Rnd 8 (Decrease): SI st in next hdc, ch 2, hdc in next 3 hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, *sk next hdc, hdc in next 4 hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from * around; join with sI st in top of beg ch - 40 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 9: SI st in next hdc, ch 2, hdc in next 2 hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp,* sk next hdc, hdc in next 3 hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from * around; join with sI st in top of beg ch - 30 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 10: SI st in next hdc, ch 2, hdc in next hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, *sk next hdc, hdc in next 2 hdc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from * around; join with sI st in top of beg ch - 20 hdc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Note: In following rnds, work first st in same st as joining.

Rnds 11-14: Ch 1, *sc in next 2 sts, FPSC around next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc - 30 sts. Fasten off.

SCARF

Ch 14.

Row 1: Hdc in 4th ch from hook (beg ch counts as hdc, ch 1), *ch 1, sk next ch, hdc in next ch; rep from * across - 7 hdc and 6 ch-1 sps.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, hdc in first ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sk next hdc, hdc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * across working last hdc in turning ch-sp.

Rep Row 2 until almost all yarn has been used. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
