SKILL LEVEL - Easy+

<u>SIZE</u>

Finished Circumference around Lower Edge About 33 in. (84 cm) Finished Circumference around Top Edge About 25 in. (63.5 cm) Finished Height About 12 in. (30.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® Bonus Bundle (Art. #641)
 - 533 Peppermint 1 ball
 - or color of your choice
- Lion Brand® crochet hook size N-13 (9 mm)
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

7 hdc-blo + 5 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

hdc-blo (half double crochet in back loop only) Yarn over, insert hook in back loop only of indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

hdc2tog-blo (hdc 2 sts together through back loops only) (Yarn over, insert hook in back loop of next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES

- Cowl is worked flat in one piece with decreases for shaping, from the bottom up. Short sides are then seamed to make Cowl.
- 2. Flowers are worked separately and sewn to Cowl.

COWL

Ch 62.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 61 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, sk first 2 sts, hdc in next st, ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next st, *hdc-blo in next 9 sts, hdc in next st, (ch 1, sk next st, hdc in next st) twice; rep from * across working last hdc in top of beg ch – 36 hdc-blo, 15 hdc, and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rows 3-7: Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, sk first st, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st, *hdc-blo in next 9 sts, hdc in next st,

(ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st) twice; rep from * across working last hdc in 2nd ch of beg ch.

Row 8 (Decrease Row): Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, sk first st, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st, *hdc2tog-blo, hdc-blo in next 5 sts, hdc2tog-blo, hdc in next st, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st) twice; rep from * across working last hdc in 2nd ch of beg ch – 28 hdc-blo, 15 hdc, and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rows 9-11: Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, sk first st, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st, *hdc-blo in next 7 sts, hdc in next st, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st) twice; rep from * across working last hdc in 2nd ch of beg ch.

Row 12 (Decrease Row): Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, sk first st, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st, *hdc2tog-blo, hdc-blo in next 3 sts, hdc2tog-blo, hdc in next st, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st) twice; rep from * across working last hdc in 2nd ch of beg ch – 20 hdc-blo, 15 hdc, and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rows 13-15: Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), turn, sk first st, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st, *hdc-blo in next 5 sts, hdc in next st, (ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, hdc in next st) twice; rep from * across working last hdc in 2nd ch of beg ch.

Row 16: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st and ch-1 sp across. Fasten off.

Flowers (make 3)

Ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 8 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, working in front loops only, (sc, ch 3, sc) in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc - 8 (sc, ch 3, sc) petals.

Rnd 3: Working in back loops of Rnd 1 sts, (sc, ch 6, sc) in back loop of each st of Rnd 1; join with sl st in first sc - 8 (sc, ch 6, sc) petals. Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

FINISHING

Sew sides of Cowl together. With yarn tails, sew flowers along seam.

Weave in ends.
