

**Alphabet Granny Squares
Pattern and Graphs
by Mary Walker**



Materials

Your choice of yarn

I used medium weight Red Heart Super Saver colors cherry and turquoise to show high contrast

Any Hook size to achieve the gauge of your choice

Tapestry or large sewing needle

Notes

Since the gauge does not need to be matched exactly the overall size can be changed by adjusting yarn weight and hook size, feel free to experiment.

Color changes for each letter are graphed in the additional pages with this pattern.

In this pattern we're working in the round all stitches are to be repeated for each of the four sides to create a square.

Abbreviations

US Terms used

mr=magic ring

ch=chain

dc=double crochet

hdc=half double crochet

FO=finish off weave in ends

Instructions

R1 2 dc, 3 ch on mr (8dc, 12ch)

R2 corner 2 dc, 3 ch, 2 dc then dc in each stitch (24 dc, 12ch)

R3 corner 2 dc, 3 ch, 2 dc then dc in each stitch (40dc, 12ch)

R4 corner 2 hdc, 3 ch, 2hdc then hdc in each stitch (56hdc, 12ch)
