

## The Extended Mesh Stitch



#### **Description**

This crochet tutorial will help you learn how to crochet the extended mesh stitch. The extended stitch sits slightly angled, and when combined with classic mesh, it makes a drapey fabric. The extended mesh stitch would be great for shawls, scarves and shrugs!

#### **Stitch Details**

Skill Level Intermediate

**Row Count**Number of Rows: 1

Pattern Repeat
Any odd number

#### **Abbreviations**

**CH** - Chain Stitch

**Esc** - Extended Single Crochet- Insert hook in next stitch or chain, yarn over and pull up loop (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 1 loop (1 chain made), yarn over and pull through 2 loops.

### **Pattern Instructions**

Foundation Chain: Any odd number.

Row 1: (Right Side): esc, in 5th ch from hook (counts as esc, ch 1 sp), \*ch 1, skip 1ch, esc in next ch; rep from \* across, turn.

Row 2: ch 3 (counts as esc, ch 1 sp), \*skip next ch 1 sp, esc in next esc, ch 1; rep from \*



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across to turning ch, esc in top of turning ch, turn.

Repeat row 2 until you have reached your desired length.
