



The Extended Mesh Stitch



Description

This crochet tutorial will help you learn how to crochet the extended mesh stitch. The extended stitch sits slightly angled, and when combined with classic mesh, it makes a drapey fabric. The extended mesh stitch would be great for shawls, scarves and shrugs!

Stitch Details

Skill Level
Intermediate

Row Count
Number of Rows: 1

Pattern Repeat
Any odd number

Abbreviations

CH - Chain Stitch

Esc - Extended Single Crochet- Insert hook in next stitch or chain, yarn over and pull up loop (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 1 loop (1 chain made), yarn over and pull through 2 loops.

Pattern Instructions

Foundation Chain: Any odd number.

Row 1: (Right Side): esc, in 5th ch from hook (counts as esc, ch 1 sp), *ch 1, skip 1ch, esc in next ch; rep from * across, turn.

Row 2: ch 3 (counts as esc, ch 1 sp), *skip next ch 1 sp, esc in next esc, ch 1; rep from *



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across to turning ch, esc in top of turning ch, turn.

Repeat row 2 until you have reached your desired length.
