## The Trefoil Lattice Stitch



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## Stitch Details

Skill Level
Intermediate

Row Count
Number of Rows: 2

Pattern Repeat
Multiples of $10+2$

## Abbreviations

CH - Chain Stitch DC - Double Crochet
Sc - Single Crochet
V-st - V Stitch - [dc, ch 1, dc] in st indicated
Trefoil - [ch 3, (sc, ch 4) 3 times, sc, ch 3] in st indicated

## Pattern Instructions

Foundation Chain: Multiples of $10+5$
Row 1: (Right Side): dc in 5th ch from hook, *skip 4ch, trefoil in next ch, skip 4ch, v-st in next ch; rep from * across, turn.

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Row 2: ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2 sp ), [sc, ch 4 , sc, ch 3 ] in ch 1 sp , sk next ch 4 sp , ${ }^{*}$ v-st in next ch 4 sp, trefoil in next ch 1 sp, skip next ch 4 sp; rep from * across to last trefoil, v-st in next ch 4 sp , ch 3 , [sc, ch 4 , sc, ch 2, dc] in 4 th ch of turning chain ,turn.

Row 3: ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 sp ), dc in ch 2 sp, *trefoil in next ch 1 sp, skip next ch 4 sp , v-st in next ch 4 sp ; rep from * across to last ch 1 sp , trefoil in next ch 1 sp , sk next ch $4 \mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{v}$-st in turning ch, turn.

Last Row: ch 1 , sc in dc, *ch 4 , sk next ch 4 sp, sc in next ch 4 sp, ch 4 , sc in ch 1 sp ; rep from * across working last sc in turning ch, fasten off.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until you have reached your desired length.



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    ## Description

    This crochet tutorial will help you learn how to crochet the trefoil lattice stitch.
    This stitch creates a delicate lace pattern.
    The diamond lattice stitch would be great for shawls, scarves and shrugs!
