



# The Braided Lace Stitch



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## Description

The Braided Lace Stitch is a great lace pattern that uses basic chain stitches and single crochets to create a loopy lace mesh. It's a perfect stitch for shawls, blankets, scarves, and even hats!

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## Stitch Details

Easy

**Row Count**

Number of Rows: 3

**Pattern Repeat**

Multiples of 2

**ch** - [Chain Stitch](#)

**sc** - [Single Crochet](#)

**dc** - [Double Crochet](#)

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## Pattern Instructions

Foundation Chain: Multiples of 2

Prep Row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each ch across row, turn.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in first st, \*ch 5, skip next st, 1 sc in next st, rep from \* across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, 1 sc in center ch of next ch-5 loop, \*ch 1, sc in center ch of next ch-5 loop, rep from \* across, 1 dc in last sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, 1 sc in first sc, 1 sc in next sc, \*1 sc in next ch-1 space, 1 sc in next sc, rep from \* across, 1 sc in top of turning ch, turn.

*Repeat rows 1 – 3 until you have reached your desired length.*



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
