Description

The Crunch Stitch is a simple pattern that creates a tightly textured fabric that looks like it has been crunched. It's great from potholders, washcloths, afghans, scarves, and anything you want to be durable and warm.

Stitch Details

Skill Level

Row Count

Number of Rows: 1

Pattern Repeat

Multiples of 2

Abbreviations

ch - Chain Stitch

hdc - Half Double Crochet

Pattern Instructions

Foundation Chain: Multiples of 2 (add 1 for base chain)

Row 1: skip 2ch (count as 1 hdc), *sl st into next ch, 1 hdc into next ch; rep from * ending sl st into last ch, turn.

Row 2: 2ch (count as 1 hdc), skip 1 st, *sl st into next hdc, 1 hdc into next sl st; rep from * ending sl st into top of tch, turn.

Repeat 2nd row until you have reached your desired length.



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
