

The Duchess Lace Stitch



Description

The Duchess Lace Stitch is a wonderful stitch with interlocking shells in a criss-cross diamond-like pattern.

It's a great stitch for blankets, washcloths, and scarfs.

Stitch Details

Skill Level Easy Row Count Number of Rows: 2 Pattern Repeat Multiples of 3 + 1

Abbreviations

ch - Chain Stitch

sc - Single Crochet

dc - Double Crochet

Pattern Instructions

Foundation Chain: Multiples of 3 + 1

Prep Row: [2 dc, ch 3, 1 Sl st] in 4th ch from hook, *skip next 2 ch, [2 dc, ch 3, 1 Sl st] in next ch; rep from across, turn.

Row 1: Ch 3, *[2 dc, ch 3, 1 Sl st] in next xh-3 space; rep from * across, 1 dc in top of turning ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3, *working in each ch of the ch-3 of previous row, 1 dc in first ch, 1 dc in 2nd ch, ch 3, 1 SI st in 3rd; rep from * across, end 1 dc in top of the turn ch, turn.

Repeat rows 1 – 2 until you have reached your desired length.



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
