

The Honeycomb Mesh Stitch



Description

The Honeycomb Mesh Stitch is an open mesh stitch pattern that forms hexagons when stretched. Also known as the Hexagon Net Stitch, it is a great choice for wraps, shawls, and bags.

Stitch Details

Skill Level Intermediate Row Count
Number of Rows: 1

Pattern Repeat Multiples of 4 + 10

Abbreviations

ch - Chain Stitch

dc - Double Crochet

Pattern Instructions

Foundation Chain: Multiples of 4 + 10

Row 1: Skip 9ch, *1dc in next ch, 4ch, skip 3ch,* rep from * to last st, 1dc, turn.

Row 2: 7ch, *1dc in 5ch sp, 4ch,* rep from * to last ch sp, 1dc, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until you have reached your desired length.



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
