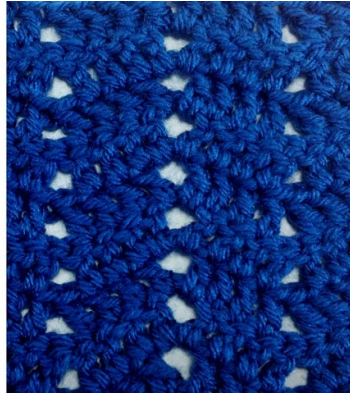




# The Keyhole Ripple Stitch



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## Description

The Keyhole Ripple Stitch is a traditional crochet ripple technique. It is perfect for making afghans and warm shawls.

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## Stitch Details

### Skill Level

Easy

### Row Count

Number of Rows: 1

### Pattern Repeat

Multiples of 10 + 3

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## Abbreviations

**ch** - Chain Stitch

**dc** - Double Crochet

**sc** - Single Crochet

**hdd** - Half Double Crochet

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## Pattern Instructions

Foundation Chain: Multiples of 10 + 3

Prep Row: 1 dc in 4th ch from hook, 1 dc in each of next 3 ch, \*skip next 2 ch, 1 dc in each of next 4 ch, ch 2, 1 dc in each of next 4 ch; rep from \* across to within last 6 ch, skip next 2 ch, 1 dc in each of next 2 ch, 2 dc in next ch, 1 dc in last ch, turn

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), skip first dc, 2 dc in next dc, 1 dc each of next 2 dc, \*skip next 2 dc, 1 dc in each of next 3 dc, [1 dc, ch 2, 1 dc] in next ch-2 space, 1 dc in each of next 3 dc; rep from \* to within last 6 dc, skip 2 dc, 1 dc in each of next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in top of turning ch, turn

*Repeat row 1 until you have reached your desired length.*



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
