



# The Peacock Fan Stitch



## Description

The Peacock Fan Stitch is an easy lacy openwork stitch. It is named for the half-circle fans that it forms, reminiscent of a peacocks fanning feathers. It would look great on a hat or a shawl.

## Stitch Details

**Skill Level**

Easy

**Row Count**

Number of Rows: 2

**Pattern Repeat**

Multiples of 10 + 2

## Abbreviations

**ch** - Chain Stitch

**hdc** - Half Double Crochet

**sc** - Single Crochet

**dc** - Double Crochet

## Pattern Instructions

Foundation Chain: Multiples of 10 + 2

Prep Row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, \*skip 4 cha, 11 tr in next ch (fan made), skip next 4 ch, 1 sc in next ch; rep from \* across, turn

Row 1: Ch 4 (counts as tr) 1 tr in first sc, \*ch 5, sc in the 6th tr of next fan, ch 5\*\*, [1 tr, ch 1, 1 tr] in next sc; rep from \* across, ending last rep at \*\*, 2 tr in last sc, turn

Row 2: Ch 1 (counts as first sc), 1 sc in next tr, \*skip next ch-5 space, 11 tr in next sc, skip next ch-5 space, 1 sc in next ch-1 space; rep from \* across, ending last rep with 1 sc in last tr, sc in top of turning ch, turn

*Repeat rows 1 & 2 until you have reached your desired length.*



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
