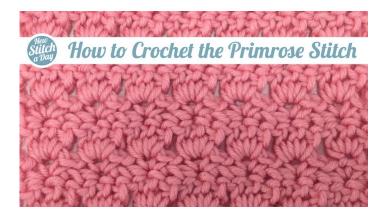


## **The Primrose Stitch**



Description

The Primrose Stitch is a dense yet feminine stitch. It would work well for bags, sweaters, or hats.

## Stitch Details

<b>Skill Level</b> Easy	Row Count Number of Rows: 2	Pattern Repeat Multiples of 3 + 2
Abbreviations		
<b>ch -</b> <u>Chain Stitch</u>	hdc - <u>Half Double Crochet</u>	
sc - Single Crochet	dc - Double Crochet	

## Pattern Instructions

Foundation Chain: Multiples of 3 + 2

Prep Row: Work [1 sc, ch 2, 1 sc] in 3rd ch from hook, \*skip next 2 cha, [1 sc,ch 2, 1 sc] in next ch, rep from \* across, ending with 1 hdc in last ch, turn.

Row 1: Ch 3, \*3 dc in next ch-2 space (shell made), rep from \* across, ending with 1 dc in top of turning ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), \* [1 sc, ch 2, 1 sc] in 2nd dc of next shell, rep from \* across, ending with 1 hdc in top of turning ch, turn.

Repeat rows 1-2 until you have reached your desired length.
