



The Aligned Puff Stitch



Description

The Aligned Puff Stitch creates a visually appealing and entirely symmetrical fabric composed of small puffs. This stitch would work best for scarves and home decor items.

Stitch Details

Number of Rows: 2

Pattern Repeat

Multiples of 2 + 1

Abbreviations

ch - [Chain Stitch](#)

hdc4tog - Half Double Crochet Four Together

sc - [Single Crochet](#)

hdc - [Half Double Crochet](#)

Pattern Instructions

Foundation Chain: Multiples of 2 + 1 (add 1 for base chain)

Row 1: (right side) 1sc into 2nd ch from hook, *1ch, skip 1ch, 1sc into next ch; rep from * to end, turn.

Row 2: 2ch (count as 1hdc), skip first st, *hdc4tog all into next ch sp, 1ch, skip sc; rep from * ending hdc4tog into last ch sp, 1hdc into last sc, skip tch, turn.

Row 3: 1ch, 1sc into first st, *1ch, skip 1 st, 1sc into next ch sp; rep from * ending in top of tch, turn.

Repeat rows 2 – 3 until you have reached your desired length.
